TEAM EVENT (1) (Subject to a minimum number of entries, at least 6 teams from 4 NPCs)

Giant Slalom

5 athletes, both genders, all classes represented.



Rules for Team Competitions

Both genders must have representation in the team and in the result, in the following way:

Results calculation will take the best three results of the team, being mandatory to have at least one result of each gender.

All Categories (Visually Impaired, Sitting and Standing) must be represented in the team's composition

Nations may enter two teams in the event. *(A max number of teams will be determined and 1 slot allocation will be granted to each NPC before two slots are allocated to any other NPC)*

The competitors of the individual teams must be named before a draw.

The placing of the teams will be determined by addition of the race times.

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

Athletes must:

Hold a valid IPCAS License for the 2008/2009 season.

All new athletes obtaining an IPCAS license will have to be previously IPCAS Internationally Classified. **There will be no Classification at the WCH**

In order to be eligible for competition, the athletes/guides must turn 15 years old during the competition year.

for Technical Events

Be ranked and have 200 IPCAS Points or less on the IPCAS Slalom and/or Giant Slalom Points Lists respectively as of 1 February 2009.

for Super G

Be ranked and have 120 IPCAS Points or less on IPCAS Super G Points List as of 1 February 2009.

for Downhill

Be ranked and have 120 IPCAS Points or less on IPCAS Downhill Points Lists as of 1 February 2009 (in the case that no valid downhill list is available the IPCAS Super G Points List will be used).



for Super Combined

Be ranked and have 120 IPCAS Points or less on IPCAS Super Combined Points Lists as of 1 February 2009 (in the case that no valid Super Combined list is available the IPCAS Super G Points List will be used).

for Team Event

Be ranked and have 200 IPCAS Points or less on the IPCAS Slalom and/or Giant Slalom Points Lists respectively as of 1 February 2009.

NPC Delegation Quota Formula

Npcs' shall be allowed to enter the following number of staff per athlete:

From 1 to 5 athletes 5 Staff, plus VI-guides

From 6 to 10 athletes 11 Staff, plus VI-guides

Above 10 athletes 1 additional staff to every 2 athletes (rounded up)

Extra Staff: Chef de Mission and one (1) Team Doctor
