



Participation in IPC Alpine Skiing Competitions

1) IPC Alpine Skiing World Championships

- For Speed and Super Combined Disciplines, the athlete must be below 120 IPCAS Points from the Downhill or Super-G IPCAS list using the valid IPCAS Point List one month prior to the event.
- For Technical Disciplines the athlete must be below 200 IPCAS Points from the Slalom IPCAS list and below 200 IPCAS Points from Giant Slalom IPCAS list using the valid IPCAS Point List one month prior to the event.

2) IPC Alpine Skiing World Cups

- For Speed and Super Combined Disciplines the athlete must be below 120 IPCAS points from the Downhill or Super-G IPCAS lists;
- For Technical Disciplines the athlete must be below 100 IPCAS points respectively from the Slalom IPCAS list and below 100 IPCAS points from Giant Slalom IPCAS list.

The published valid lists to be used are defined in Rule 1263.1

- A hosting nation of a World Cup may apply one (1) month before the race to the IPC Alpine Skiing STC for a maximum of 6 wildcards in technical events (Slalom and Giant Slalom).

* Each athlete must be IPC internationally classified before starting at an IPC Alpine Skiing World Cup and World Championships.

* For races of level 2, 3 or 4, if the jury is uncertain of the athlete's classification and the athlete has not been internationally classified the athlete must start in the higher class.
