

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1 Introduction

The City of New Delhi — Paralympic Committee of India (PCI) and World Shooting Para Sport (WSPS) are pleased to invite you to New Delhi 2024 WSPS World Cup.

The competition will be held in New Delhi, INDIA from 06 – 15 March, 2024

1.1 Organisation and Administration

1.2 Location

New Delhi is the capital of India and a part of the National Capital Territory of Delhi (NCT). With a total area of 42.7 km2 (16.5 sq mi) the municipality of New Delhi forms a small part of the Delhi metropolitan area. New Delhi is a cosmopolitan city due to the multi-ethnic and multi-cultural presence of the vast Indian bureaucracy and political system. New Delhi is home to several historic sites and museums.

2 Competition Information

2.1 Date of Competitions

The New Delhi 2024 WSPS World Cup will feature a full Program of Rifle, Pistol, Para Trap, and Visually Impaired (VI) Events (R1-R9, P1-P5, PT1-PT3, VIS, VIP).

2.2 Ceremonies

2.2.1 Opening Ceremony And Closing Ceremony

Their will be no opening or closing ceremony.

1.1.1 Victory Ceremony

The Victory Ceremonies will take place at the shooting range **immediately after the end of each Final** (see also: Victory Ceremony schedule for exact details). During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

1.3 Preliminary Program



The provisional program will be published on the WSPS competition page. The program will be finalised and published after the final entry deadline.

1.4 Competition Duration

The competition duration is based on the minimum days of competition plus 2 additional days for Equipment Control and training.

1.5 Rules and Regulations

The competition will be conducted under WSPS and ISSF Technical Rules and Regulations and WSPS Classification Rules and Regulations.

WSPS Juries (Jury of Appeal, Competition Juries, RTS Jury, and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by WSPS to supervise the New Delhi 2024 WSPS World Cup. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable WSPS licenses will conduct the competitions.

1.6 Equipment Control

1.6.1 Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to WSPS Rules and ISSF rules using approved, calibrated instruments. The tag is only for ISSF clothes and rifle. All athletes must pass the equipment control for the wheelchair and all SH2 athletes must control the balance, the spring and wheelchair, following the schedule publishes on WSPS web and send to the Team leader/NPC.

All athletes must have their BIB number for the equipment control check.

1.6.2 Shotgun Equipment

Equipment control will be conducted at the shotgun range on 09 March 2024 from 10:00 to 14:00.

1.7 Eligibility Criteria for Participation



1.7.1 Athlete Eligibility

To be eligible athletes must:

1. Hold an active WSPS License for the 2024 Season.

1.8 Maximum Entry per NPC

The maximum entry per NPC is four (4) per event if one is a junior in P1-P2, R1-R2 or R7-R8. If no junior athletes are entered, the maximum number of entries is three (3). In mixed events, the maximum number of entries per NPC is four (4) if one is a female or junior. If no female or junior athletes are entered, the maximum number of entries is three (3).

The maximum entry per NPC is two (2) mixed teams.

1.10 VI Events

All athletes will be responsible to bring their own LED lights to the competition that will be mounted to the targets.

1.11 Results, Ranking & Records

After the competition is finished, results will be reviewed and published on the WSPS website and the Ranking and Records lists will be updated accordingly.

1.12 Paris 2024 Direct Quota Allocation

The World Cup will be a direct quota allocation event for the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games. Below is the distribution of quotas by event:

1.13 Viability of Events

Events are considered viable if they have a minimum of four (4) countries entered after Entry by Number. One set of medals per event will be awarded

Team Events will be considered viable if they have a minimum of three (3) eligible NPCs have entered teams through the entry by name (note: in where only 3 teams participate, medals will be awarded according to the minus-one rule).

Mixed Team Events will be considered viable if they have a minimum of four (4) eligible NPCs have entered teams through the entry by name.

Otherwise, events are not considered viable and will be cancelled.

NPCs may additionally enter up to 05 members in MQS only athletes per event (athletes are eligible to obtain qualification scores to be recognized for MQS but cannot progress to the event final or obtain records or rankings.) However, in case of insufficient firing points this number may be restricted by WSPS, in a timely manner. Do not forget to register your teams and Mixed teams, it will only be possible up to 3 days before the arrival day.

1.14 International Classification

International Classification will only be conducted for Physically Impaired (PI).

1.15 Anti-Doping

Doping control will be conducted in accordance to the IPC Anti-Doping Code. For further information visit: http://www.paralympics.org/shooting/RulesandRegulations/AntiDoping



2 Registration Process

2.1 Entries and Registration

All athletes must be entered by their respective NPCs or Organisations authorised by the NPC and accepted by WSPS.

All NPCs must declare their entries within the given deadlines.

2.2 Late Entries

Late entry applications (submitted after the final entry deadline by name) will only be considered if they are received by the WSPS at least one (1) month before the official day of arrival.

Such entries may be accepted under the direction of the LOC and WSPS: however, a late entry fee of USD 120 per additional start per athlete per event.

2.3 Replacement entries

Replacement entries may be accepted in the same event only due to injury or medical reason. the NPC must submit a valid medical report to WSPS office for approval. The LOC must also approve if such late changes can be accommodated (e.g., firearms import arrangement). Refer to WSPS Appendix 2- 5.3.1

2.4 Accreditation

All persons involved in the New Delhi 2024 WSPS World Cup (Athletes, Team Officials, WSPS Officials, LOC Officials, Media Persons) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline and who have a photograph in the IPC SDMS database) will be prepared by WSPS and the LOC. All other accreditations will be prepared by the New Delhi 2024 WSPS World Cup Accreditation Office. Accreditations and bib numbers will be distributed by the Organising Committee after payment of the entry fees.

All accreditation cards will be handed out at the registration centre at the range. Only the team leader for each country will be able to confirm the accreditation of all the members of their delegation and check the events on the validation form.

2.5 Media Relations

All Media representatives must register for the New Delhi 2024 WSPS World Cup by using the Media Accreditation Form.

The four official hotels offer 5* level services and are adapted for wheelchairs with a limited number of fully adapted rooms.

4 Accommodation, Meals and Transportation

4.1 Official Championships Hotel

The LOC will house all athletes and staff, the NPC team, and any and observers in Four (4) Official Championship Hotels.

Accommodation must be made for a minimum stay of five (5) days.

ALL ACCOMMODATION BOOKINGS AND PAYMENTS MUST BE MADE DIRECTLY WITH THE LOC. This will be done via the SDMS accommodation system.



The Hotel will be in charge only to collect any necessary extra costs incurred during your stay (i.e., laundry, telephone, mini bar, etc).

The hotel fees will not be refunded.

For the organisation of accommodation for early arrivals and days outside of the World Shooting Para Sport Championships, please contact the LOC to make arrangements: accommodation.ndwc@paralympicindia.org.in

All teams must be accommodated in the Official hotels only.

4.2 Meal Service

Meal service (breakfast, lunch and dinner) is included during the Championship period.

The first meal is Breakfast on 6th March, 2024. The last meal is Dinner on 15th March, 2024.

Breakfast and dinner will be served at the Official Hotels, lunch will be only at the shooting range.

Any specific dietary, allergy or diathesis requirements must be notified to the LOC in detail when submitting the registration form.

4.3 Transportation

Distance from Indira Gandhi International Airport (DEL) to Official Championship Hotels is Approximately 45 minutes depending on the traffic conditions.

LOC will provide transportations service from Indira Gandhi International Airport (DEL) to the Official Championship Hotel. Arrival & Departure Transport Service (Airport – Hotel-Airport) will be provided on the designated Official Arrival and departure Days $6^{th}-15^{th}$ March, 2024. Transportation outside of the official arrival and departure days must be coordinated in advance with the LOC and an additional fee will be set according to the size of the group email: transport.ndwc@paralympicindia.org.in

LOC will operate a daily shuttle bus (wheelchair accessible) from the Official Championship Hotels and competition venue for the duration of the Championships. The daily shuttle schedule will be published at the hotels and on the range.

This transportation is including the transfer of firearms and ammunition from the airport to the armoury of the shooting range.

NOTE: The LOC will not refund or be in charge for any taxi fare payment.



5 Firearms & Ammunition

5.1 Import/Export

All delegations must complete the Air Arms, Firearms and Ammunition Form and return it to LOC before the Final Registration Deadline (29th January, 2024); attaching the following documents:

- Fill out the Weapon Form
- Passport scanned photo
- Gun License scanned
- Property card scanned (In case that the athlete travels with the guns of this Federation, he must attach a document of the same)
- The flight itinerary: name of the airline, flight number, date and time of arrival and departure.

The LOC will not be responsible to the Airport Authorities for any incorrect information provided by the NPC related to airguns, firearms, and ammunition.

The Athlete may take back the unutilized ammunition but however it is advised to deposit it with LOC for unnecessary delay while going back to the respective countries.

5.2 Airlines

All NPCs are requested to check with their Airline all the required documents pertaining to import/export of firearm and ammunition.

5.3 Ammunition – Rifle/Pistol/Shotgun

Ammunition are not allowed on carry-on baggage and/or with the firearm. Ammunition should be in a separate baggage.

The athlete may return to his country the ammunition that he had not used.

The following ammunition will be available for sale at the competition.

12 Bore RC4 Ammunition - USD 75/- per 100 Rounds

.177 H & N air pellets - USD 13/- per Tin

.22 Eley Tenex ammunition - USD 42/- per 100 Rounds

5.4 Transportation and Storage

It is forbidden under Indian Law to store firearms and ammunition in the hotel. Upon your arrival in New Delhi, India, all firearms and ammunition will be transported by the Person in charge from the airport to the Shooting Range directly.



Upon departure, all firearms will be removed from the armoury for direct transit to the airport only, not before.

The armoury will be opened from the Official Arrival Day until the Official Departure Day, any teams arriving/departing outside of these dates should advise the LOC so alternate arrangements can be made with the Shooting range.

NOTE: All athletes are requested to put labels on their gun boxes and ammunition packages mentioning their NPC name and the name of the athlete.

6 Other Information

6.1 Insurance

All participating teams (athletes & team officials) attending this event must ensure they have the appropriate personal, medical and travel insurance.

Each National Federation and/or National Paralympic Committee is responsible for the appropriate insurances for accidents, health, property and liability of their team. The LOC is not liable for any cases.

6.2 Visa

NPCs are responsible for obtaining a visa if necessary. Please contact the organizers for the official invitation letter. You can find information about visas, between India and other countries here:
