Alpine Skiing World Cups NZL & AUS and Winter Games New Zealand

This document contains advice for travellers partaking in the New Zealand Winter Games, the Snow Sports NZ Alpine Skiing World Cup, and the Australian Paralympic Committee IPC Alpine Skiing World Cup.

Travelling Internationally to Queenstown for NZ Winter Games

Flying from Europe and other distant continents to Queenstown, New Zealand (NZL) will generally involve 2 or 3 flights. The most directly way to travel to Queenstown is via Sydney, Australia (AUS).

Most major international airlines offer direct flights tit Sydney or over two legs, depending on the distance and the country you are travelling from.

Travelling from Queenstown to Methven/Christchurch for IPCAS World Cup Races

Option 1 (recommended)

CAR: The easiest and most cost effective way to travel in a group from Queenstown to Methven and Christchurch is via a one way car hire. A car can be hired for between NZD \$200 - \$400 per day, depending on the size and model of the vehicle.

Option 2

FLY: Flights between Queenstown and Christchurch are available via Air New Zealand for approximately NZD \$80 - \$200 per passenger.

Flight time: 1 hour (to Christchurch)
Drive time to Methyen: 1 hour

<u>Travelling from Christchurch to Thredbo (via Sydney) for IPCAS WC Races</u>

Direct flights are available daily from Christchurch, NZL tot Sydney, AUS via Air New Zealand, Virgin Australia, Qantas and Jetstar (websites listed above). Additionally, Emirates also operates between these cities.

Option 1 (recommended)

CAR: One way car hire is available from Sydney Airport from the following providers:

A car can be hired between AUD \$115-\$300 per day, depending on the size and model of the vehicle.

Note that an additional insurance fee is applicable for driving hire cars above the snowline. To avoid an unnecessary incursion of costs, please ensure this is highlighted at the point of booking.

All 2 wheel drive vehicles are required by law to travel with snow chains in Australia. Chains can be hired in Jindabyne for approximately AUD \$25 per day.

FLY + CAR: Qantas and Virgin Australia offer directs flights from Sydney to Canberra. Once in Canberra, car hire will need to be obtained via one of the service providers listed above.
