2014 IPC Athletics European Championships Final Entry Process

Dear NPC President/Secretary General,

IPC Athletics will open the online entry system (EBS) for Final Entry by Name for the 2014 IPC Athletics European Championships, Swansea, Wales, via http://www.paralympic.org/sdms/ebs/login.php, on 03 July 2014.

NPCs will be able to generate their competition fee invoice for the European Championships directly from the EBS based on its confirmed overall team delegation size. The competition fee that applies to these Championships is 550 Euros per person regardless of length of stay, payable to IPC Athletics by 24 July 2014. Please note that no amendments to the invoice will be permissible after submission by 24 July 2014 except for athlete withdrawals due to non-viability of all his/her entered events.

The full amount of the competition fee payment indicated in the invoice must be paid to a designated IPC Athletics bank account no later than **24 July 2014** Bank details can be found in the invoice. Please note that incomplete payment will result in all athletes from your delegation being ineligible to compete. No reimbursements will be granted after the payment.

IPC Athletics acknowledges in certain countries/territories the restrictions to transfer money abroad. In the event of such difficulty, please contact IPC Athletics on ipcathletics@paralympic.org for an alternative payment option. Please note absolutely no cash payment in any kind for the competition fee will be accepted by IPC Athletics without its prior approval.

Accreditation for athletes and their competition partner(s) i.e. guide-runner(s) will be directly dealt by IPC Athletics through EBS once the respective NPC has completed its Entry by Name.
