Decision of the IPC Legal and Ethics Committee

IPC v Paralympic Council of Malaysia

The IPC Legal and Ethics Committee (**LEC**) was convened to hear a complaint brought by the IPC against the Paralympic Council of Malaysia (**NPC Malaysia**) relating to the events surrounding the 2019 World Para Swimming Championships (due to be held in Malaysia).

It was alleged that NPC Malaysia had breached certain provisions of the IPC Code of Ethics, specifically in relation to ensuring that all eligible athletes, support personnel and countries would be able to participate.

Following written submissions from both parties, the LEC found that the complaint had not been proven on the balance of probabilities. The ethics complaint against NPC Malaysia was therefore dismissed.
