ALLOCATION OF QUALIFICATION SLOTS

The qualification slot is allocated to the individual athlete, not to the NPC.

MAXIMUM QUOTA ALLOCATION PER NPC

An NPC may be allocated no more than, **ten (10) female and ten (10) male qualification slots**. Exceptions may be granted through the Bipartite Commission Invitation Allocation method.

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for selection by an NPC, athletes must:

- 1. hold an active World Para Powerlifting Athletes License for the 2022 season;
- 2. be internationally classified in an eligible Sport Class with a Sport Class Status of (i) Confirmed; or (ii) Review with a Fixed Review Date of 2023 or later;
- 3. be ranked in the World Para Powerlifting Asian Para Games Hangzhou 2022 Ranking List closing 15 July 2022 (inclusive).

Exceptions may be granted to criteria 3 through the Bipartite Commission Invitation Allocation method.

MAXIMUM ENTRY PER NPC

An NPC may enter a maximum of two (2) eligible female athletes and two (2) eligible male athletes per medal event. Exceptions can be granted through the Bipartite Invitation Commission Allocation method.

PARIS 2024 PARALYMPIC GAMES

This competition will provide an opportunity for athletes to increase their Paralympic Rankings for Paris 2024 only if the athlete has competed in the Asia-Oceania Open Championships in Pyeongtaek, KOR or got granted a WPPO extenuating circumstances.

15 July 2022	Deadline for NPCs to submit the Entry by Name to APC and HAPGOC Deadline for NPCs with athletes ranked in more than one bodyweight category and /or more than ten (10) athletes per gender ranked in the top eight (8) for female and ranked in the top eleven (11) for male of their respective bodyweight category to declare in writing to World Para Powerlifting both the medal event that their athlete(s) wish to compete in and/or which ten (10) athletes per gender they wish to be allocated a qualification slot.
	If an NPC fails to submit this declaration, WPPO will take this decision with no opportunity for protest or appeal, based on the results of the most recent competition.
