

COVID-19 Safety Protocol for Bangkok 2022 World Para Ice Hockey Championships C-Pool

1. All athletes, assistants, coaches and ITOs (participants) to be tested a ATK - COVID-19 test at the hotel after you arrive in Thailand or on 2nd of December. If a test is negative, you can participate in the activities as usual. If a test is positive athletes will have to isolate in their rooms for the required period in a single occupancy room. Teams will be financially responsible for the additional single room during the isolation period.
2. The second times ATK - Test will be conducted on 5th December 2022, a day before the competition starts.
3. All participants will have their temperature taken daily.
4. All participants are recommended to wear face masks while in public area.
5. All coaches are recommended to wear face masks while in public area.
6. Social distancing rules will be applied when off court.
7. The third times ATK - Test will be conducted on 9th December 2022.
8. If a team or participant requires an antigen test or a PCR test to return to their home country, they must request it to the LOC COVID Officer with the specific date and time the test should be administered based on the home country national regulations. This departure test is not included in the event testing package and will be the financial responsibilities of the team.
9. Please make sure to check for any specific COVID requirements by the airline(s) you will be traveling with.
10. Please contact your COVID Officer in case you feel any covid related symptoms or if you have been in close contact with a person who has symptoms or tested positive. Your COVID officer will contact the LOC COVID Officer for advice.
11. A participant in isolation who breaks the isolation rules, will have his or her accreditation revoked and will be expelled from the tournament.
12. Any changes in the regulations, as well as orders and input from national and local health authorities, will be continuously included and updated in the COVID-19 protocol and communicated with the teams.

As a result of any isolation periods The LOC will liaise with the hotel and support the team with requirements. As previously stated, athletes and team officials must ensure they have appropriate medical insurance to cover routine medical healthcare, including COVID-19 care if reciprocal home country arrangement do not apply.

For clarity, all scenarios that may require a period of self-isolation are stated below

Scenario	Symptom	COVID -19 Test Result (ATK)	Identified as close contact	Action	Notes
1	Yes	Positive	No	Isolate for 5 days from start of symptoms or day of test whichever comes first	Can end isolation after 5 days if does not have symptoms or the negative test result
2	No	Positive	Yes	Isolate for 5 days from start of symptoms or day of test whichever comes first	Can end isolation after 5 days if does not have symptoms or the negative test result
3	No	Negative	No	No Action	

As a safety measurement the LOC recommend everyone traveling to the World Championships to minimize social interaction, wear a mask, and avoid enclosed spaces and crowds where possible the week before traveling to Thailand.

Entry Thailand (Updated as of November 2022)

Travelers entering Thailand are not required to show Proof of Vaccination or COVID-19 test results. All travelers can freely travel to Thailand without any COVID restrictions.

Travelers are not required to obtain Thailand Pass or Certificate of Entry (COE).

Travel Insurance is still highly recommended when you travel to Thailand. Before you travel to Thailand, you should buy your travel insurance for your protection to cover your entire trip to Thailand.
