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1 Introduction

The City of Lima - Perú, National Paralympic Association of Perú (ANPP) and World Shooting Para Sport (WSPS) are pleased to invite you to Lima 2023 WSPS World Championships.

The competition will be held in Lima, PERU from 19 – 29 September 2023.

1.1 Organisation and Administration

The Local Organising Committee (LOC) will handle the administrative procedures of the Championships in association with WSPS. The LOC is as follows:

1.2 Location

Lima is the capital of the Republic of Perú. It is located on the central coast of the country, on the shores of the Pacific Ocean, forming an extensive and populated urban area known as Metropolitan Lima; It has more than 10 million inhabitants (32% of the Peruvian population), figures that make it the most populous city in the country.

2 Competition Information

2.1 Date of Competitions

The Lima 2023 WSPS World Championships will feature a full Program of Rifle, Pistol, Para Trap, and Visually Impaired (VI) Events (R1-R9, P1-P5, PT1-PT3, VIS, VIP).

2.2 Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting rifle and pistol will take place on 21 September 2023 at 15:00 the shooting range / Finals Hall and shotgun on 22 September 2023 at 15:00. Each participating WSPS Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding final schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to Lima 2023 WSPS World Championships.

2.3 Ceremonies

2.3.1 Opening and Closing Ceremony

The Opening Ceremony will take place on 21 September 2023 at 17:00 at the Competition Venue.

The Closing Ceremony will take place on 28 September 2023. Exact time and venue will be communicated at the Technical meeting.

2.3.2 Victory Ceremony

The Victory Ceremonies will take place at the shooting range immediately after the end of each Final (see also: Victory Ceremony schedule for exact details). During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

2.4 Venue

2.5 Preliminary Program

2.6 Competition Duration

The competition duration is based on the minimum days of competition plus 2 additional days for Equipment Control and training.



2.7 Rules and Regulations

The competition will be conducted under WSPS and ISSF Technical Rules and Regulations and WSPS Classification Rules and Regulations.

WSPS Juries (Jury of Appeal, Competition Juries, RTS Jury, and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by WSPS to supervise the Lima 2023 WSPS World Championships. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable WSPS licenses will conduct the competitions.

2.8 Equipment Control

2.8.1 Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to WSPS Rules and ISSF rules using approved, calibrated instruments. The tag is only for ISSF clothes and rifle. All athletes must pass the equipment control for the wheelchair and all SH2 athletes must control the balance, the spring and wheelchair, following the schedule publishes on WSPS web and send to the Team leader/NPC.

All athletes must have their BIB number for the equipment control check.

2.8.2 Shotgun Equipment

Equipment control will be conducted at the shotgun range on 22 September 2023 from 10:00 to 14:00.

2.9 Eligibility Criteria for Participation

2.9.1 Athlete Eligibility

To be eligible athletes must:

1. Hold an active WSPS License for the 2023 Season.
2. Be internationally classified with a "Review" (R) or "Confirmed" (C) sport class status on or before September 2023.
3. Have achieved a Minimum Qualification Score (MQS) at a WSPS Recognised Competition.

2.9.2 MQS

Athletes must have achieved a Minimum Qualification Score (MQS) at a WSPS recognised competition for one event between **01 January 2022 and 15 September 2023**. An athlete may compete in multiple events if they have achieved the MQS score in each event.

2.10 Maximum Entry per NPC

The maximum entry per NPC is four (4) per event if one is a junior in P1-P2, R1-R2 or R7-R8. If no junior athletes are entered, the maximum number of entries is three (3). In mixed events, the maximum number of entries per NPC is four (4) if one is a female or junior. If no female or junior athletes are entered, the maximum number of entries is three (3).

The maximum entry per NPC is two (2) mixed teams.

2.12 VI Events

All athletes will be responsible to bring their own LED lights to the competition that will be mounted to the targets.

2.13 Results, Ranking & Records

After the competition is finished, results will be reviewed and published on the WSPS website and the Ranking and Records lists will be updated accordingly. For the WCH all athletes must have the MQS and the classification.

2.14 Paris 2024 Direct Quota Allocation

The World Championships will be a direct quota allocation event for the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games. Below is a proposal of the distribution of quotas by event:

2.15 Viability of Events

Events are considered viable if they have a minimum of four (4) countries entered after Entry by Number. One set of medals per event will be awarded

Team Events will be considered viable if they have a minimum of three (3) eligible NPCs have entered teams through the entry by name (note: in where only 3 teams participate, medals will be awarded according to the minus-one rule).

Mixed Team Events will be considered viable if they have a minimum of four (4) eligible NPCs have entered teams through the entry by name.

Otherwise, events are not considered viable and will be cancelled.

2.16 International Classification

International Classification will NOT be conducted during these Championships. All athletes must have a valid International Classification prior to this competition.

2.17 Anti-Doping

Doping control will be conducted in accordance to the IPC Anti-Doping Code. For further information visit:

3 Registration Process

3.1 Entries and Registration

All athletes must be entered by their respective NPCs or Organisations authorised by the NPC and accepted by WSPS.

All NPCs must declare their entries within the given deadlines. If an athlete hopes to obtain an MQS in August, they must be entered by the entry deadlines.



3.2 Late Entries

Late entry applications (submitted after the final entry deadline by name) will only be considered if they are received by the WSPS at least one (1) month before the official day of arrival.

Such entries may be accepted under the direction of the LOC and WSPS: however a late entry fee of EUR 100 per additional start per athlete per event.

3.3 Replacement entries

Replacement entries may be accepted in the same event only due to injury or medical reason. the NPC must submit a valid medical report to WSPS office for approval. The LOC must also approve if such late changes can be accommodated (e.g., firearms import arrangement). Refer to WSPS Appendix 2- 5.3.1

3.4 Accreditation

All persons involved in the Lima 2023 WSPS World Championships (Athletes, Team Officials, WSPS Officials, LOC Officials, Media Persons) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline and who have a photograph in the IPC SDMS database) will be prepared by WSPS and the LOC. All other accreditations will be prepared by the Lima 2023 WSPS World Championships Accreditation Office. Accreditations and bib numbers will be distributed by the Organising Committee after payment of the entry fees.

All accreditation cards will be handed out at the registration centre at the range. Only the team leader for each country will be able to confirm the accreditation of all the members of their delegation and check the events on the validation form.

3.5 Media Relations

All Media representatives must register for the Lima 2023 WSPS World Championships by using the Media Accreditation Form.

5 Accommodation, Meals and Transportation

5.1 Official Championships Hotel

The LOC will house all athletes and staff, the NPC team, and any and observers in four (4) Official Championship Hotel.

Accommodation must be made for a minimum stay of five (5) days.

ALL ACCOMMODATION BOOKINGS AND PAYMENTS MUST BE MADE DIRECTLY WITH THE LOC.

The Hotel will be in charge only to collect any necessary extra costs incurred during your stay (i.e., laundry, telephone, mini bar, etc).

Check in at the hotel is 15:00 hrs and check out is 12:00 noon.

The hotel fees will not be refunded.

For the organisation of accommodation for early arrivals and days outside of the World Shooting Para Sport Championships, please contact the LOC to make arrangements:

All teams must be accommodated in the Official hotels only.



5.2 Meal Service

Meal service (breakfast, lunch and dinner) is included during the Championship period. The first meal is dinner on September 19, 2023. The last meal is breakfast on September 29, 2023.

Breakfast and dinner will be served at the Official Hotels, lunch will be only at the shooting range.

Any specific dietary, allergy or diathesis requirements must be notified to the LOC in detail when submitting the registration form.

5.3 Transportation

Distance from Jorge Chavez International Airport (LIM) to Official Championship Hotels: Approximately 45 minutes

LOC will provide transportations service from Jorge Chávez (LIM) International Airport to the Official Championship Hotel. Arrival & Departure Transport Service (airport – hotel - airport) will be provided on the designated Official Arrival and departure Days 19-29 September 2023. Transportation outside of the official arrival and departure days must be coordinated in advance with the LOC and an additional fee will be set according to the size of the group email: transportation@lima2023.pe

LOC will operate daily shuttle bus (wheelchair accessible) from the Official Championship Hotels and competition venue for the duration of the Championships. The daily shuttle schedule will be published at the hotels and on the range.

This transportation is including the transfer of firearms and ammunition from the airport to the armoury of the shooting range.

NOTE: The LOC will not refund or be in charge for any taxi fare payment.

6 Firearms & Ammunition

6.1 Import/Export

All delegations must complete the Air Arms, Firearms and Ammunition Form and return it to LOC before the Final Registration Deadline (**July 17, 2023**); attaching the following documents:

- Fill out the SUCAMEC - affidavit form for each athlete (per weapon) if they enter with 5 guns, there must be 5 formats. LEGIBLE LETTER
- Passport scanned photo
- Gun License scanned
- Property card scanned (In case that the athlete travels with the guns of this Federation, he must attach a document of the same)
- The flight itinerary: name of the airline, flight number, date and time of arrival and departure.

The LOC will not be responsible to the Airport Police for any incorrect information provided by the NPC related to airguns, firearms, and ammunition.

All information related to the import and export permit for arms and ammunition must be directed to the following email: gun-import@lima2023.pe



6.2 Airlines

All NPCs are requested to check with their Airline all the required documents pertaining to import/export of firearm and ammunition.

6.3 Ammunition – Rifle/Pistol/Shotgun

Ammunitions are not allowed on carry-on baggage and / or with the firearm. Ammunitions should be in a separate baggage.

The athlete may return to his country the ammunition that he had not used.

6.4 Transportation and Storage

It is forbidden under Perú law to store firearms and ammunition in the hotel.

Upon your arrival in Lima, all firearms and ammunition will be transported by the Person in charge from the airport to the Shooting Range directly.

Upon departure, all firearms will be removed from the armoury for direct transit to the airport only, not before.

The armoury will be opened from the Official Arrival Day until the Official Departure Day; any teams arriving/departing outside of these dates should advise the LOC so alternate arrangements can be made with Shooting range.

NOTE: All athletes are requested to put labels on their gun boxes and ammunition packages mentioning their NPC name and name of the athlete.

7 Other Information

7.1 Insurance

All participating teams (athletes & team officials) attending this event must ensure they have the appropriate personal, medical and travel insurance.

Each National Federation and/or National Paralympic Committee is responsible for the appropriate insurances for accidents, health, property and liability of their team. The LOC is not liable for any cases.

7.2 Visa
