8. INFORMATION ON RANGE EQUIPMENT

The trap ranges are equipped with “LaPorte” throwing machines. The targets used during the Para Trap World Cup will be White Flyer: Standard orange for Qualification rounds, flash for Finals.

9. JURY OF APPEAL, JURY, RANGE REFEREES

Qualified Range Referees holding a valid official ISSF Shotgun Referee license will officiate at the competition after completing a Para Trap Referee course on June 25, 2024.

10. EQUIPMENT CONTROL

The equipment control will be carried out at the shooting range on June 26, 2024.

11. WEATHER INFORMATION

The climatic conditions in June are normally mild. The average temperatures are expected to be 20°/25° degrees Celsius during the day and 15°/20° degrees Celsius during the night. Weather is subject to change.
