8. NPCs / NFs Services and Visas Information

The Accreditation will not function as a visa to enter the country. It is the responsibility of each National Paralympic Committee (NPC) or National Federation (NF) to verify and arrange their visa, if necessary, in a timely manner.

9. Airport Information

The official Port of Entry for the Para Athletics Grand Prix Cali 2025 will be the Alfonso Bonilla Aragón Internacional Airport (CLO) located in the city of Palmira and serving the city of Cali. It is 21 km away and approximately 20 minutes from the city and 40 minutes from the hotel zone.

The airport has two National Terminals (A and B) and one International Terminal (C) where Avianca Airlines, Delta Airlines, American Airlines, and Copa Airlines operate, among others.

At the airport there will be an Arrivals and Departures Coordinator as well as a group of Volunteers who will guide and accompany each of the delegations to the transport pick-up point that will transfer them to the respective hotel, according to the established schedule.

For the delegations that make their entry to Colombia through the El Dorado International Airport in the city of Bogotá, there will be a group of Volunteers who will guide them to the appropriate exit from the international terminal towards the national terminal to make the necessary connection.



a. Flight Information

The LOC will request NPCs / NFs to complete their flight information which must be sent in full and in time to guarantee transportation service at the airport. If the information is not provided as requested, this service cannot be provided. The deadline for submission of flight information is 11 April 2025.

10. Entry Deadlines and Accreditation

The entry registration starts on 17 February 2025 and shall be done via the IPC Online Entry System. The final entry deadline is 21 March 2025 (23:59 CET).

The accreditation is the only official pass offering rights and privileges according to its category. Accreditations will be given to the Head of each delegation during the official Delegation Registration Meeting (DRM) to be held at the Dann Carlton Hotel, according to the schedule of arrival times.

11. Registration and Package

The registration fee is mandatory for teams to receive their accreditations and have access to all services. Registration is open to athletes from all NPCs/ NFs who meet the eligibility requirements (Clause 4.2) set out in the WPA Rules and Regulations.

All participating athletes must hold an active IPC Athlete License for the 2025 season.

After the registration period which closes on 21 March 2025 at 23:59 (CET), an invoice for bank transfers and payments will be issued until 11 April 2025 at 16:00 (GMT-5). Registration will be considered complete ONLY AFTER the payment has been received by the bank, by April 11th, 2025, at the latest.

a. Event Registration Fee

- Accommodation (double or triple occupancy) check in at 14:00, check out at 12:00
- There will only be one single room available per country
- Transport to and from the airport to the host hotel on arrival and departure days
- Transport to and from the host hotel to the venue
- Internet access in hotel and venue
- Meals from dinner on arrival day to breakfast on departure day

b. Accommodation

Bookings will be in double and triple accommodation at the Dann Carlton (<https://hotelesdann.com/en/hotels-in-cali/>) which is a **5-star hotel**.

Any arrival or departure, outside of the official Event period, will be the responsibility of the athlete or team to arrange their own transport.

Please kindly note that early departure does not confer entitlement to a reduced fee. Additionally, the LOC is not responsible for any missed flights due to traffic delays.

I. Additional fees:

- Extra night \$150 USD (including breakfast) in double or triple accommodation.
- Extra night \$200 USD (breakfast included) in single accommodation.
- Extra meals will be charged at a cost of \$25 USD.

12. Refunds

If a refund is necessary, the following must be considered:

- Before 25th April, only 50% of the payment will be refunded.
- After 25th April, no refunds will be issued.

After the registration period, the LOC will send teams an invoice with all bank details so that the payment can be made.



13. Services Deadline

The LOC will promptly send the forms to complete the information required for accommodation and transportation services. This information must be submitted within the established deadlines.

14. Payment process and Banking Information

All banking information will be forwarded before the registration deadline.

15. Medical services

The Local Organization Committee (LOC) will have emergency care and first aid on site during the Event and will provide transportation to the appropriate hospital (medical center) for all athletes, team officials, staff, officers, WPA representatives as well as any other accredited people.

16. Insurance

The participating teams must have their own international health insurance for each member of their delegation during the whole Event period.

17. Classification

International classification for PI, VI and II will be available at the Cali WPA Grand Prix for all athletes with a status of New (N), Review (R) or Review with a Fixed Review Date of 2025 (R-2025) or earlier for three days: 13 to 15 May 2025. To be eligible for classification athletes need to be licensed for the 2025 season and entered in the IPC Online Entry System before the entry deadline (21 March, 23:59 CET).

World Para Athletics (WPA) will provide the Classification Schedule to the Local Organizing Committee (LOC) which will be responsible for distributing it to each NPC or NF.

Please note that it is the responsibility of each Team Leader to ensure that the athletes



listed on the Classification Schedule are available and present for their Evaluation Session at least 30 minutes prior to the assigned time, date, and location. This allows sufficient time for the ID check, as well as to review and sign the Athlete Evaluation Agreement Form.

18. Anti-doping

The Anti-doping controls will be carried out by the Nacional Anti-Doping Organization which is the national agency for the World Anti-Doping Agency (AMA).



19. Venue



The International Athletics Stadium Pedro Grajales has an 8-lane Mondo track, 2 high jump areas, 2 areas for long jump and triple jump, including landing zones in both directions with a width of 3 m, a permanent discus cage and 1 portable cage for seated throws, 2 javelin throwing areas, 2 throwing circles for ambulant throwers and an adequate number of throwing platforms for seated athletes, as well as a 4 – lane Mondo warm – up track.

20. Competition

The Appeal Fee will have a cost of 200 EUR.



21. Technical meeting

The Technical Meeting will be held in person on Thursday, May 15th 2025 at 17:00 at the Dann Carlton Hotel (room to be defined). Only one team representative per NPC / NF will be allowed to attend the Technical Meeting.

a. Questions for the Technical Meeting

All questions and proposals concerning the procedures of the competition must be made in English by using the “Questions for the Technical Meeting” form which will be shared in advance. The Form must be submitted no later than May 14th, 2025, at 16:00. A summary of all submitted questions and answers will be shared with the Team Leaders before the Technical Meeting.

For an event to be eligible for a medal, at least two (2) para-athletes from different NPCs / NFs must be officially entered. Each para-athlete may enter 5 individual Track and Field, events and one relay.

As a reward for the athletes, the first 3 new world records happening during the event will be awarded **\$ 1.000 USD**.

Considerations for the award

This award will be granted to the new world record holder per event per athlete.

This award can be granted to the same athlete if they break the world record in different events.

This award will be granted **ONLY** to the first three **NEW** world Records regardless of how many new world records happen during the Grand Prix Cali 2025.
