The information below provides details related to the list of events, qualification criteria and deadlines for the New Delhi 2025 World Para Athletics Championships

1. Championships Dates

22 September 2025:	Team Arrival date
23 September 2025:	Training starts
23 - 25 September 2025:	Classification dates
27 September - 5 October 2025:	Championships dates
6 October 2025:	Team Departure date

2. Athlete Eligibility

To be eligible to compete in the Championships, all athletes and guide-runners (regardless of the route of qualification and including all athletes who receive a Direct Invitation to compete) must meet all the eligibility requirements set out in Regulation 4.2 of the World Para Athletics Rules & Regulations.

3. Qualification Requirements

In accordance with Regulation 4.4 of the World Para Athletics Rules & Regulations, in addition to the eligibility requirements referred to above, to qualify for potential selection by an NPC for the Championships, all athletes must meet the following qualification requirements:

1. hold an active WPA Athlete License for the 2025 season;
2. be internationally classified in an eligible Sport Class with a Sport Class Status of (i) Confirmed; or (ii) Review with a Fixed Review Date of 2026 or later;
3. have achieved one (1) Minimum Entry Standard (MES) performance at a WPA Recognised Competition for each of their respective events between 1 January 2024 and 3 August 2025 (inclusive) in accordance with the terms of the WPA Athlete Licensing Regulations valid for the 2024-2025 seasons.

In relation to criterion 2 above, NPCs are permitted to provisionally select athletes with a Sport Class Status of (i) New; (ii) Review; and (iii) Review with a Fixed Review Date of 2025 or earlier, subject to such athletes attending an Evaluation Session prior to or during the Championships (including any required in-competition Observation Assessment).

Exceptions may be granted to criterion 3 above via the Direct Invitation method.

To be eligible for a Relay Event, athletes must be entered into an individual Medal Event.

4. Qualification and Entry Timeline

1 January 2024	Start of the qualification period for athletes to achieve MES performances
17 February 2025	Start date to submit Preliminary Entry by Number WPA appreciates the cooperation of teams to provide a realistic estimate of team size during this phase that will assist in an appropriate publication of the Preliminary Event Programme.
14 March 2025	Deadline to submit Preliminary Entry by Number
2 June 2025	Start date to apply for a Direct Invitation
2 June 2025	Opening of Online Entry System for Entry by Number The correct Entry by Number data is important to allow accurate planning for the Championships services and programme. Therefore, please enter accurate numbers of qualified athletes for both male and female events. The submitted data should not include any anticipated Direct Invitation applications. Any increase to team size as a result of a successful Direct Invitation application will be adjusted by WPA.
7 July 2025	Deadline for Entry by Number NPCs will be invoiced based on the number provided at this entry deadline. No reimbursements allowed after this deadline. No withdrawal is possible after this entry deadline, with the exceptions referred to in section 11.
8 July 2025	Opening of Online Entry System for Entry by Name
3 August 2025	End of qualification period for athletes to achieve MES performances

5. Entry Forms

All Online Entry Forms (Entry by Number and Entry by Name) must be submitted through the IPC Online Entry System <https://db.ipc-services.org/sdms/app/login>.

6. Maximum Entry per NPC

An NPC may enter a maximum of three (3) eligible athletes per individual Medal Event provided each has achieved at least one (1) MES performance in that event.

NPCs may enter a maximum of one (1) team in the Relay Event.

NPCs may enter an eligible athlete in an unlimited number of individual Medal Events as long as the athlete has achieved a MES performance in each respective Medal Event.

In the event that two or more classes in Field Events are combined following the final entry by name and event viability review (e.g., Shot Put F53/54/55), an NPC may not exceed a maximum of five (5) eligible athletes in a combined Medal Event. However, per each sport class, a maximum of three (3) eligible athletes can be entered.

7. Event Viability Criteria

A minimum of five (5) athlete entries from three (3) NPCs is necessary to sustain an individual Medal Event on the programme. A minimum of five (5) entries from five (5) NPCs is necessary to sustain the Relay Medal Event on the programme.

World Para Athletics shall review the event viability following the close of the final Entry by Name on 8 August 2025. In the case an event did not meet the above viability criteria by final entry, World Para Athletics reserves the right to combine such an event with other events where appropriate and applicable.

World Para Athletics also reserves the right to either cancel such events or run them as non-medal events.

In the case where entry numbers of an event fall below the aforementioned event viability criteria due to withdrawals after 8 August 2025, WPA reserves the right to still run the event as a Medal Event and the medals will be allocated under the principle of 'minus one'. This means that an event remains valid for medal distribution as long as there are at least one fewer than the minimum required eligible athletes for a full competition. Where the number of entries is below the minimum required for a full competition, medals are awarded as follows: four entries only gold and silver; three entries only gold. If the number of eligible athletes drops below this threshold, the event may still be held, as a Non-Medal event, with no medals awarded.

8. Direct Invitation

World Para Athletics reserves the right to directly invite a limited number of eligible athletes under the following criteria:

- To enable the greater representation by nation;
- To ensure events featured on the programme have sufficient representation for viability;
- To enable greater representation by gender;
- To ensure the representation of athletes with high support needs;
- To ensure top athletes that may have not had the opportunity to formally qualify due to extraordinary circumstances;
- To ensure new athletes that may have not had the opportunity to be formally classified due to extraordinary circumstances.

NPCs must submit a formal request for a Direct Invitation slot to World Para Athletics by 4 August 2025

All Direct Invitation slots are at the sole discretion of World Para Athletics. World Para Athletics has no obligation to award any Direct Invitation slots, regardless of whether or not NPCs / athletes meet the Direct Invitation criteria set out in this section.

9. Qualification Rounds

9.1. Seated Throw Events

Should a seated throw event exceed twelve (12) entries at the close of final entry, a qualification round may be held to allow the competition to be conducted in a single round (final). Should the qualification round be held, the top 8 entered athletes (based on qualification performances) shall proceed to the final without competing in the qualification round. The top 4 athletes from the qualification round shall proceed to the final.

9.2. Ambulant Throw and Long Jump Events

Should ambulant throw and long jump events exceed sixteen (16) entries at the close of final entry, a qualification round may be held to allow the competition to be conducted in a single round (final). Should the qualification round be held, the top 12 entered athletes (based on qualification performances) shall proceed to the final without competing in the qualification round. The top 4 athletes from the qualification round shall proceed to the final.

9.3. Track Events

Should a track event from 100m to 800m exceed 24 entries (28 entries for classes T11 & T12) at the close of final entry, a qualification round may be held to allow the competition to be conducted in a maximum of two rounds (first round & final) or three rounds for classes

T11 & T12 (first round, semi-final and final). Should the qualification round be held, the top 18 entered athletes (based on qualification performances) shall proceed to the first round without competing in the qualification round. The top 6 athletes from the qualification round shall proceed to the first round.

9.4. Qualification Round Timetable

Qualification rounds may be held in a non-ticketed session outside of the official programme. In all throw events, athletes will have a maximum of three trials in the qualification round.

10. Competition Fee

The Competition Fee covers Championships competition services from 22 September to 6 October 2025 (from official arrival to departure date). The Competition Fee for the Championships is 800 EUR per Team Member.

11. Financial Regulations

The Competition Fee is to be paid to World Para Athletics in accordance with the invoice generated from the Online Entry System (SDMS) based on the confirmed team delegation size.

Following the deadline of Entry by Number (7 July 2025) there will be no reimbursement, with the exception of an athlete entered into only non-viable event(s) or due to a medical reason (in this case, official medical documents are required to be presented to World Para Athletics) as per World Para Athletics Regulations "6.3 Medical withdrawal request".
