Paralympians and Olympians want their own identity. Media coverage might not be fair and spectators would have to choose which events to watch if both events run together.

The Greek word 'para' means 'beside' and reflects that fact that currently the Olympic Games and Paralympic Games remain separate events, that run alongside (parallel to) each other.
