Classifications

The New Delhi 2025 will offer classification opportunities in the days prior to the start of the competition. International Classification panels will be available for the following impairments:

- VI Visual Impairment
- II Intellectual Impairment
- PI Physical Impairment

An athlete will only be allowed to undergo classification if he or she:

- Has an active World Para Athletics active license;
- Has been entered into the Recognised Competition where International Classification is to take place;
- Has uploaded a Medical Diagnostics Form (MDF), for athletes with PI or VI impairment to SDMS within the specified deadlines.

World Para Athletics aims to schedule all athletes with New (N) and Review (R) sport class status for classification. Should there be more athletes than the available slots on the schedule, WPA will allocate classification slots to NPCs.

Athletes who require classification must arrive prior to the start of classification. Therefore, they need to purchase the Gold package.

Athletes scheduled for classification should take note of the Athlete Evaluation Requirements of the World Para Athletics Classification Rules and Regulations.

All NPC/NF delegations must comply with the World Para Athletics Classification Rules and Regulations.

Entry Information

Athletes who will be eligible to enter the competition shall meet the following requirements:

Holding an active World Para Athletics athlete license

Competition will strictly comply with the World Para Athletics Rules and Regulations. No minimum entry standard are required to enter the competition.

Accommodation

The New Delhi Grand Prix 2025 will offer 4/5-star hotels as accommodation options for delegations during the competition.

Team leaders will be directly informed of their assigned hotels during the booking phase. Hotel assignments will be made on a "first come, first serve" basis.

Teams in need of fully accessible rooms are advised to indicate this request when booking.

Priority for accessible rooms will be given to athletes in certain categories, ensuring their comfort and specific needs are met throughout the event.



Packages and Entry Fees

Gold Package:

- Single Room: \$1250 per person
- Double/Triple Room: \$950 per person
- Includes:
 - Accommodation from 7th March to 14th March 2025
 - Full board (meals included)
 - Transportation (airport transfers and local event-related travel)

Silver Package:

- Single Room: \$800 per person
- Double/Triple Room: \$600 per person
- Includes:
 - Accommodation from 10th March to 14th March 2025
 - Full board (meals included)
 - Transportation (airport transfers and local event-related travel)

Bank charges are always covered by the sender.

If requested, booking extra night opportunities will be available but will be calculated separately.

- 3. Deadline for the Payment of the Package Fees- 15th February 2025

Booking policy

Hotel reservations will be handled on a **first-come**, **first-served basis**, subject to room availability.
