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1 Competition information

Czech Disabled Shooting Association, Czech Paralympic Committee and World Shooting Para Sport (WSPS) are pleased to invite you to the Brno 2025 WSPS Para Trap World Championships. The competition will be held in Brno, Czechia from 09 - 15 September 2025.

1.1 Dates of Competition

The Brno 2025 WSPS Para Trap World Championships will be a Para Trap only competition.

1.1.1 Preliminary schedule

The provisional timetable will be updated and published after the final entry deadline.

1.1.2 Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place on 11 September 2025 at 15:30 at the shooting range. Each participating WSPS Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding final schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to Brno 2025 WSPS Para Trap World Championships.

1.1.3 Victory Ceremony

The Victory Ceremony will take place on 14 September 2025 at the shooting range (The Ceremony schedule for exact details will be provided at the technical meeting). During the ceremony the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

1.1.4 Equipment Control

The Equipment Control will be conducted at the shooting range on 12 September 2025 from 10:00 to 14:00.

1.3 Rules and Regulations

The competition will be conducted under ISSF and World Shooting Para Sport Rules and Regulations. If you require further information, please visit the following websites:

- World Shooting Para Sport: www.paralympic.org/shooting/rules
- ISSF: www.issf-sports.org/rules

WSPS Juries (Competition Juries) will be designated by WSPS to supervise the Brno 2025 WSPS Para Trap World Championships. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable ISSF/WSPS licenses will conduct the competition.

1.4 Viability of Events

Individual events are considered viable if there are athletes from a minimum of four (4) countries entered through the Entry by Name.

Team events will be considered viable if a minimum of three (3) eligible NPCs have entered teams through the Entry by Name (note: in cases where only 3 teams participate, medals will be awarded according to the minus-one rule).

Mixed team events will be considered viable if a minimum of three (3) eligible NPCs have entered teams through the Entry by Name.

Otherwise, events are not considered viable and will be cancelled.

1.5 International Classification

International Classification will NOT be conducted during the event. All athletes must have a Confirmed or Review with a fixed date (no later than 31 December 2025) class status in order to be eligible.



1.6 Results, Rankings & Records

After the competition is finished, results will be published on the World Shooting Para Sport website and the Ranking and Records lists will be updated accordingly.

Only athletes that are licensed, have a sport class status Review (R) or Confirmed (C) and reach the rankings cut-off standard for the relevant event, will have their results recognised for ranking purposes.

2 Registration Process

2.1 Athlete Eligibility

All entered athletes in the Brno 2025 WSPS World Championships must be licensed by the final entry deadline. Athletes' entries not meeting this criteria will be rejected by WSPS.

2.2 MQS Scores

Athletes must have achieved a Minimum Qualification Score (MQS) at a WSPS recognised competition for one event between **01 January 2024 and 30 August 2025**.

2.3 Authorized Organisation for Entry Registration

All athletes must be entered by their respective NPCs or organizations authorized by the NPC and accepted by WSPS.

2.4 Entry restrictions

2.4.1 Maximum number of athlete entries per NPC per event

The maximum number of entries per NPC is four (4) if one is a female or junior. If no female or junior athlete are entered, the maximum number of entries is three (3).

2.4.2 Maximum number of starts per event

Event	Maximum number of starts
*PT1 (Trap Seated)	48
*PT2 (Trap Lower Limb)	48
*PT3 (Trap Upper Limb)	48

2.4.3 Maximum number of teams per NPC

*PT1 (Trap Seated)	one team per event per NPC
*PT2 (Trap Lower Limb)	one team per event per NPC
*PT3 (Trap Upper Limb)	one team per event per NPC
Mixed Team	two teams per event per NPC

*If viable after Entry by Number

Team scores will be calculated by adding the individual event scores of the athletes within a team together.

2.5 Late Entries

Late Entry Requests (submitted after the Final Entry by Name deadline) will only be considered if they are received by World Shooting Para Sport at least three (3) weeks before the official arrival.

Such entries may be accepted at the discretion of the LOC and WSPS; however, a late entry fee of **EUR 100** will be charged per additional start per athlete per event.

2.6 Entry Changes

- 2.6.1 **Replacement entries** may be accepted in the same event only due to injury or medical reason. The NPC must submit a valid medical report to WSPS office for approval. The Organising Committee must also approve if such late changes can be accommodated (e.g. firearms import arrangements). Refer to WSPS Appendix 2 – 5.3.1.

2.7 Registration deadlines

The Registration deadlines (midnight CET ['Bonn-time'] (GMT +1) on the dates given) for the competition shall be as follows:

1 July 2025	First Entry (by number) Deadline , via the IPC Online Entry System (www.paralympic.org/entries). NPCs must submit the total number of athletes and team officials participating, and the number of entries estimated per individual and team event.
2 July 2025	Opening of the Final Entry (by name) , via the IPC Online Entry System (www.paralympic.org/entries).
11 August 2025	Final Entry (by name) Deadline , including Accommodation, Travel information and Firearms information.
17 August 2025	Transfer of Payment Deadline

2.8 Online Entry Process

The log-in details are the same username and password used for the SDMS account.

If you do not have access to the SDMS/Online Entry System, please contact your NPC. The NPC will be able to make the online entry on your behalf.

NOTE: The IPC Online Accreditation System will be used for all accreditations.

2.9 Accreditation system

In order to make your necessary accommodation booking, and ensure transport and accreditation for your team, you must submit your **Final Entry via the online accreditation system** by the final entry deadline (**11 August 2025**).

The system must contain the following information for your team:

- **Page 1:** Accreditation List; (Names should be exactly as per the passports)
- **Page 2:** Accommodation Booking Request
- **Page 3:** Transport Information
- **Page 4:** Firearms and Ammunition Information

NOTE: All updated information or requests should be communicated to the LOC through the accreditation system ONLY.

All persons involved in the Brno 2025 WSPS World Championships (Athletes, Team Officials, WSPS Officials, LOC Officials, Media Persons) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function).

Accreditations will be prepared by WSPS and the LOC. All persons must be entered in the SDMS accreditation/accommodation system by the deadline.

THE LOC WILL NOT TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION ANY INCOMPLETE INFORMATION.

ANY FEDERATIONS WITH INCOMPLETE INFORMATION WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE

3.5 Transportation

3.5.1 Airport transfers

The official airports for the Brno 2025 WSPS Para Trap World Championships are:

- **Vaclav Havel Airport Prague (PRG)**

The airport is located 235 kilometers from the shooting range.

- **Brno Airport (BRQ)**

The airport is located 15 kilometers from the shooting range.

Transfers between the airports and the Official Championship Hotels during the competition period (08-15 September 2025) will be provided based on the arrival and departure dates declared by the NPC.

Transfers are covered within the Hotel Fee.

Transportation outside the official arrival and departure days must be communicated in advance with the LOC and an additional fee may be set according to the size of the group.

3.5.2 Hotel-venue daily shuttle

Transport will be provided between the official hotels and the shooting range for the duration of the competition (09-14 September 2025) and is covered within the Hotel Entry Fee.

4 Other important information

4.1 Firearms and ammunition

4.1.1 Import/Export

EU citizens holding a "European Firearms Pass" can import their firearms into the Czech Republic without an auxiliary permission provided that the temporarily imported firearm is listed on their European Firearms Pass and they can present the reason for the journey (in particular by presenting an official invitation).

International athletes NOT holding a "European Firearms Pass" must submit the application for a permit for transit of firearms or ammunition at the Czech Embassy/Consulate in their country or the nearest one well in advance of their departure. The application must be accompanied by an official invitation.

For the official invitation, please complete the Invitation Letter Request Form.



On the territory of the Czech Republic, firearms may not be carried visibly (i.e. the firearm must be in a cover). During the entire period of stay in the Czech Republic, foreign shooters - holders of Gun Waybill or European Firearms Pass must carry this document at all times and must be able to present this document and the official invitation at any check by the Police of the Czech Republic.

All foreign shooters must comply with the general requirements for safe storage and transport in terms of the Czech Firearms Act. Firearms or ammunition must be under their direct supervision.

4.1.2 Airlines

All NPCs are requested to check with their official airline all the required documents pertaining to import/export of firearm and ammunition.

4.1.3 Transportation and Storage

The armoury (firearms storage) is located at the shooting range.

NOTE: All athletes are requested to put labels on their gun boxes and ammunition packages mentioning their NPC name and name of the athlete.

4.1.4 Ammunition

The following ammunition will be available for purchase at the shooting range during the Brno 2025 Para Trap World Championships:

- Sellier & Bellot Paratrap 24g
- Clever Mirage T2 Competition 24g
- Clever Mirage T4 Pro-Extra Evolution 24g

NOTE: Sellier & Bellot Para Trap ammunition will be available free of charge to all competitors for use in official training, pre-event training and competition for a maximum of 425 cartridges / person.

4.2 Visa

NPCs are responsible for obtaining a visa if necessary. Please contact the LOC for the official invitation.

EU citizens can enter Czech Republic with a valid passport or with a valid ID Card. Applicants in need of Visa to enter Czech Republic should apply to the Czech Embassy/Consulate in their country well in advance before departure. 4.3 Flags and Anthems

All participating teams are requested to send the following to the LOC (susserova@czdsa.cz) by the final entry deadline:

- the national anthem in digital format (MP3)
- the national flag in digital format with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi

4.4 Insurance

All participating teams (athletes & team officials) attending this event must ensure they have the appropriate personal, medical and travel insurance. Each National Federation and/or National Paralympic Committee is responsible for the appropriate insurances for accidents, health, property and liability of their team. The LOC is not liable for any cases.

4.5 Anti - Doping

4.6 Climate
