MILANO CORTINA 2026 PARALYMPIC WINTER GAMES ACCREDITATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this document, the terms listed below shall be interpreted as follows:

"Accreditation" is the Paralympic Identity and Accreditation Card (PIAC) as defined below.

"Accredited Person" are all persons applying for, or being granted, the right to be accredited for the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games, as defined above (including, without limitation, Participants as well as employees, agents and contractors of National Paralympic Committees, International Federations, Milano Cortina 2026, IPC, IPC's Affiliates, media rights-holders and other media, Marketing Partners, competent authorities responsible for ensuring the safety and security of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games, competent authorities responsible for admission and stay in the host country of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games, competent authorities responsible for the promotion and operation of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games, World Anti-Doping Agency, other anti-doping organisations, insurance providers) and all persons applying for, or being granted a Guest Pass and/or a Day Pass for Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games competition and/or non-competition venues.

"Authorised Purposes" means the purposes referred to in Section 2 of the Information Notice (as defined below).

"Day Pass" means the nominative cards that grant temporary access for operational purposes to persons not accredited or whose accreditation does not permit automatic access to some competitive and/or non-competitive venues of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games (as defined below).

"Guest Pass" means the nominative cards that grant temporary visiting access for non-operational purposes to persons not accredited or whose accreditation does not permit automatic access to some competitive and/or non-competitive venues of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games (as defined below).

"Information Notice" means the "Information Notice on the Processing of Personal Data of Participants and other Accredited Persons for the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games" (Annex 2A), as updated from time to time, which describes the Processing activities in relation to Personal Data.

"IPC" means the International Paralympic Committee.

"IPC's Affiliates" means any entity, now existing or to be created, which is directly or indirectly controlled by the IPC.

"Marketing Partners" are all commercial partners having been granted marketing rights by the IOC or by Milano Cortina 2026 in relation to the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games.

"Milano Cortina 2026" means the Organising Committee for the Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games Milano Cortina 2026.

"Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games" means the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games in Italy, including all sport competitions, ceremonies, cultural events, torch relay and other activities organised by Milano Cortina 2026, and the IPC in connection thereto.

"Participants" are the athletes, coaches, Chef de Mission, team officials and other members of the National Paralympic Committees and International Federations delegations attending Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games.

"Paralympic Identity and Accreditation Card" or **"PIAC"** is the official document provided to each Accredited Persons to identify that they are eligible to be present at the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games. The PIAC functions as the official Paralympic document granting the Accredited Person the necessary access to perform a specific function during the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games, and (for eligible categories) as an official travel document which together with the Accredited Person's passport authorises entry into the host country of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games.

"Personal Data" means any information related to any identified or identifiable Accredited Persons.



"Process" (and its derivatives) means any operation or set of operations which is performed on your Personal Data or on sets of your Personal Data, whether or not by automated means.

"Responsible Organisation" means any organisation seeking an Accreditation and/or Guest Pass and/or Day Pass for its Accredited Persons, responsible for collecting and submitting to Milano Cortina 2026 certain Personal Data and other accreditation information on behalf of each Accredited Person who requires an Accreditation and/or Guest Pass and/or Day Pass.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

My accreditation to the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games and the issuance of a PIAC or a Guest Pass or a Day Pass are subject to my agreement (or that of my parent(s) or legal guardian(s) if under the laws applicable in my country of residence, I am a minor or without legal capacity or, in any case, if I am under 18 years old to and compliance with the following terms and conditions (the "**Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games Accreditation Terms and Conditions**"), established by the IPC and Milano Cortina 2026:

- 1. I agree to comply with and be bound by the IPC Handbook, as well as any further regulation, decision, instruction or specific obligation communicated by the aforementioned entities or my responsible organisation and any local law or regulation, including any rules issued by Milano Cortina 2026 applying more specifically to each Venue, that may apply to me. I agree that my strict compliance with the above rules is a condition to be granted and to maintain my Accreditation, PIAC and/or Guest Pass and/or Day Pass, which may be removed if I do not comply.
- 2. I acknowledge that the Accreditation (and/or Guest Pass and/or Day Pass) are the property of the IPC and/or Milano Cortina 2026 and shall not be passed on or transferred to any other person.
- 3. I have read and understood the information regarding the processing of my personal data included in the "Information Notice on the Processing of Personal Data of Participants and other Accredited Persons" (see Annex 2A below which forms integral part of these Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games Accreditation Terms and Conditions).
- 4. Where my accreditation category requires me to sign the IPC Paralympic Games Conditions of Participation Agreement, having had this brought to my attention by my National Paralympic Committee ("NPC") or International Federation ("IF") or Milano Cortina 2026, I have thoroughly read and understood the information included in the IPC Paralympic Games Conditions of Participation Agreement and acknowledge that, in the event of any discrepancy with the present Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games Accreditation Terms and Conditions, the provisions of the IPC Paralympic Games Conditions of Participation Agreement shall prevail.
- 5. I agree that I am attending the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games (including the travel to/from the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games and its preparations) at my own risk and under my own responsibility and that it is impossible to fully eliminate the relevant risks, the impact of such risks and/or of the measures to address those risks on my participation to and, where applicable, performance in the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games, despite all care taken by Milano Cortina 2026, the IPC and any other competent authorities. To the fullest extent admissible under applicable laws, I irrevocably release Milano Cortina 2026, the IPC (and their respective members, directors, officers, employees, volunteers, contractors or agents) from any liability for any kind of loss, injury or damage that I may suffer or be exposed to in connection with my participation in the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games.
- 6. With regard to the capture and use of images and/or sounds on the occasion of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games, further described in Annex 2B below which forms integral part of these Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games Accreditation Terms and Conditions, in particular:
 - a. I agree to be photographed, filmed, identified or otherwise recorded by the IPC, Milano Cortina 2026 or third parties authorised by them, and that the resulting images, audio and audio-visual recordings can be used, in their original, modified or derived form, for the maximum duration permitted by law, in any format, media or technology, and in relation to the preparation, operation, celebration and direct or indirect promotion of, or reference to, the Paralympic Games, the Paralympic Movement and/or the IPC and its activities, in a commercial or non-commercial context, but excluding any use that creates a direct commercial association between my image alone and any product or service of any third party, without my separate written consent;

- b. I agree to assign, without further authorisation from, or compensation to me or anyone acting on my behalf, all intellectual property rights in still and moving images and/or sounds that I may take or record, created within, or from the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games' areas and venues ("Content") to Milano Cortina 2026 and the IPC for the sole purpose of enforcing rights against unauthorised exploitations of the Content. For clarity, "E Accredited Media" (as defined in the News Access Rules applicable during the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games) are excluded from the copyright assignment and license terms included in the PIAC, in respect of images, created within, or from, a competitive venue of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games, exclusively when acting in a Media Capacity;
- c. I acknowledge that the IPC grants me a revocable license to use the Content for personal/private and non-commercial/non-promotional purposes compliant with the IPC Digital Media Guidelines (see <u>https://www.paralympic.org/milano-cortina-2026/guides-and-policies</u>) and other applicable requirements of the IPC, and that I shall only use the Content in a manner consistent with such license; and
- d. I agree that I will not collect, disseminate, transmit or publish any Content for any commercial purpose whatsoever, including without limitation for betting or gambling purposes.
- 7. I agree, to the maximum extent permitted by applicable laws, to waive or not to exercise any rights against the IPC, Milano Cortina 2026 and any third parties authorized by them, including without limitation the right to make derivative works or to modify the Content.
- 8. I agree to visibly wear the PIAC or Guest Pass or Day Pass at all times when I am at competitive and/or noncompetitive venues of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games, except when I am on the field of play, which includes competition and training venues, if I am a Participant, and understand that such documents are the property of the IPC and shall not be passed on or transferred to any other person.
- 9. The Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games Terms and Conditions are drafted in English, a translated version may be available. In the case of any contradiction, the English version shall prevail.
- 10. I acknowledge that my Accreditation, PIAC and Guest Pass and/or Day Pass can be removed or withdrawn with immediate effect in the IPC's or Milano Cortina 2026 's full discretion.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

This document contains important information regarding the Processing of your Personal Data as a Participant or person requiring an Accreditation or Guest Pass or Day Pass for the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games (as defined below). It indicates the organisations responsible for Processing Personal Data and explains the purposes for which such data are Processed, as well as the applicable modalities and conditions. This notice also explains how you can exercise your rights under applicable data protection laws.

Your Personal Data will be used only as necessary to achieve the purposes set out in this Information Notice. Said purposes and further explanations vary according to your function(s) at the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games. For this reason, some provisions applicable to some Accredited Persons, Participants for instance, may not apply to you if you are not a Participant. This will be specified below, when possible.

This Information Notice will be supplemented with additional information that will be provided to you, when necessary, if and where a further Processing of your Personal Data not specifically mentioned in the present notice occurs.

Milano Cortina 2026 and the IPC reserve the right to amend this Information Notice, in particular to take account of any changes in the applicable law or in case of future needs and will make diligent efforts to inform you of significant modifications. - f. **"Information Notice"** means the present document, as updated from time to time, which describes the Processing activities in relation to Personal Data.
- g. "IPC" means the International Paralympic Committee.



- h. **"IPC's Affiliates"** means any entity, now existing or to be created, which is directly or indirectly controlled by the IPC.
- i. **"Marketing Partners"** are all commercial partners having been granted marketing rights by the IOC or by Milano Cortina 2026 in relation to the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games.
- j. **"Milano Cortina 2026"** means the Organising Committee for the Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games Milano Cortina 2026.

Concerning the Processing above mentioned where Milano Cortina 2026 and the IPC act as joint data controllers, the respective responsibilities of Milano Cortina 2026 and the IPC have been determined in an agreement in compliance with applicable laws, the essence of which is reflected in the present Information Notice. In particular, under this agreement, Milano Cortina 2026 will be your main point of contact for privacy issues during Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games. Irrespective of this, you can exercise your rights against either Milano Cortina 2026 or the IPC (see Section 9 for contacts).

The IPC may also work with other third-party controllers, such as its licensees, in its pursuit of some of the Authorised Purposes where it acts as independent data controller.

Milano Cortina 2026 and the IPC reserve the right to supplement or modify the information contained in this document where they deem necessary for the success of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games. In case of any Processing of your Personal Data not described in this Information Notice, Milano Cortina 2026 and the IPC will provide adequate information to you in accordance with applicable laws.

Processing of data relating to your health in case health services are provided to you

Please note that during the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games, healthcare and medical services might be provided to you if you require assistance, notably for the monitoring and treatment of athlete injuries, illnesses, infectious diseases or any other health states at the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games.

In this case, additional Personal Data will be Processed such as health data related to your health status including medical data (doctor referrals and prescriptions, medical examination reports, laboratory tests, radiographs, etc.), illnesses, injuries and infectious diseases.

Some of your Personal Data will be shared with third party entities such as healthcare and medical service providers who may provide treatment to you during your stay at the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games.

If healthcare services are provided to you during Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games, you will be provided with a specific information notice at the appropriate time and, when legally required, your consent will be collected, before proceeding with any medical intervention or treatment, except in the case of a medical emergency requiring immediate intervention that would not allow for the provision of said information notice and the collection of consent.

Processing of Personal Data for doping control purposes

During the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games, doping control activities will be conducted as part of the anti-doping programme in relation to the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games.

If you are subject to doping controls, additional Personal Data will be Processed, including biological samples (e.g. blood and urine) and associated data. This data processing is necessary for the administration and enforcement of the IPC anti-doping rules applicable to the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games and for compliance with the World Anti-Doping Code. Your data will be Processed by the IPC, as well as third party entities such as the World Anti-Doping Agency and other relevant Anti-Doping Organisations. Further details regarding the anti-doping programme, including how your Personal Data will be Processed, shared and retained, will be provided to you through a separate notice at the appropriate time.

3. Collection of your Personal Data

Your Personal Data is collected on different occasions as required for the preparation, promotion, presentation, operation or otherwise necessary for success of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games and, in particular, when you:

- apply for an Accreditation or Guest Pass or Day Pass and complete the registration process to attend the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games;
- are provided services such as accommodation, transport, meals, or assistance;
- travel to and from Italy for the purposes of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games;
- are photographed, filmed or recorded at the occasion of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games or otherwise as part of the media coverage of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games;



- are involved in any disciplinary procedure related to a suspected or actual breach of the rules applicable to Accredited Persons or other legal procedure in connection with the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games;
- are involved in a research project conducted at the occasion of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games;
- are involved in any safeguarding procedure during the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games;
- take part in any activity in connection with the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games;
- are subject to the measures implemented by Milano Cortina 2026, the Italian authorities, the IPC and other stakeholders on the occasion of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games to protect your health and to ensure the safe staging of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games;
- qualify to compete at the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games (Participants only);
- compete at the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games (Participants only);
- are subject to anti-doping controls and procedures.

As a general principle, Milano Cortina 2026 will receive your Personal Data from your Responsible Organisation, acting as third-party data controller, transmitting your Personal Data. In addition, in certain circumstances, Milano Cortina 2026 may receive your Personal Data from any third parties where such Personal Data is necessary for the Authorised Purposes described in Section 2 above.

4. Categories of Personal Data Processed

Your Personal Data Processed by Milano Cortina 2026 and/or the IPC for the Authorised Purposes, referred to in this Information Notice, can be categorised as follows:

- a. biographical information such as family and given names, nationality, date of birth, country/region of birth, city of birth, gender, photograph, identity documents details (type, number, place of issue, local name, date of issue, date of expiry), the fact that you are a wheelchair user (if applicable) for organising your venue and providing you with the adapted services;
- b. contact and travel details such as postal address, email addresses, phone number, public social media accounts, booking number, arrival and departure information;
- c. physiological information such as height and weight (if you are a Participant whose sports and/or activity necessitate such information);
- d. information related to the participation in the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games and previous IPC and other related sporting events, such as accreditation number, sport(s) and discipline(s), team, performances, results, function, National Paralympic Committee, International Federation, registration number and sporting biographical data;
- e. other relevant information such as name, voice and likeness as may be included in still and/or moving images or sounds necessary for or in relation to the abovementioned purposes set forth in Section 2, and relevant information necessary for your compliance with the rules applicable to you if you are a Participant (as detailed in the IPC Paralympic Games Conditions of Participation Agreement), such as, without limitation, whereabouts for the conduct of the anti-doping programme, and where applicable, if you are an Accredited Person (such as, without limitation, ticketing related information).

Where deemed necessary for the Authorised Purposes (e.g. if under the laws applicable in your country of residence, you are minor or without legal capacity or, in any case, under 18 years old), Milano Cortina 2026 and/or the IPC may also Process Personal Data which relate to your parent(s), legal guardian(s) or entourage. Please provide them with a copy of this Information Notice.

Some of your Personal Data, such as some biographical information and information related to your participation in the competitions of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games or related to breaches of rules applicable to you, may be publicly disclosed, for instance for the presentation of the competition or its promotion, with due regard to your interests, rights and freedoms.

5. Recipients of your Personal Data

Your Personal Data will be made accessible to the technical service providers of Milano Cortina 2026 and of the IPC, which are processors or, as the case may be, data controllers as per applicable law, for the strict needs of their mission and in accordance with the instructions they receive.



Milano Cortina 2026 and the IPC will also share your Personal Data between them and with the IPC's Affiliates or third parties acting on their behalf, for carrying out the Authorised Purposes.

Moreover, the following recipients will have access to your Personal Data where required by their respective operations, and responsibilities in connection with the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games and Milano Cortina 2026 and the IPC will share such Personal Data with these recipients, where necessary for the Authorised Purposes:

- a. International Federations, which are responsible for the organisation of their sport at the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games;
- b. National Paralympic Committees, who select and send Participants to the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games;
- c. competent authorities, including any national authorities, which are responsible for ensuring the safety and security of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games, your admission and stay in the host country and more generally accomplish their mission to support the preparation, promotion and operation of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games in accordance with applicable laws;
- d. the Sports Dispute Resolution Panel Ltd headquartered in the UK, who has been granted authority to settle disputes in connection with the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games;
- e. the World Anti-Doping Agency ("WADA") headquartered in Canada and other Anti-Doping Organisations who fulfil their mission to fight against doping in accordance with the World Anti-Doping Code;
- f. insurance providers who may provide you insurance services;
- g. media rights holders statistics licensees and other media, who report on the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games and inform the general public or who make content or data available to third parties for approved commercial purposes such as supporting interactive entertainment products, merchandise and gaming and gambling services;
- h. Marketing Partners, Milano Cortina 2026's domestic sponsors and other commercial partners, who provide services in connection with the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games and promote their partnership with the Paralympic Movement;
- i. travel and accommodation service providers, who provide you services;
- j. partner organisations that are involved in the development of statistics and models, historical studies, scientific and other research and development projects and may receive Personal Data for such purposes, as laid out in the Authorised Purposes, acting either for Milano Cortina 2026 and/or the IPC or for themselves;
- any organisation designated by Milano Cortina 2026 and/or the IPC as a transferee of legacy and knowledge of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games for the benefit of the Paralympic Movement or any future sports or cultural events;
- I. the IOC who provides support for future Paralympic Games planning needs and optimisation processes.

Where the above-mentioned recipients consider such measure necessary for the Authorised Purposes, they may combine or supplement any of your Personal Data with any other information in their possession. You are invited to consult the websites or other official information sources made available by the above-mentioned recipients for additional information regarding their respective operations and activities and related Processing of your Personal Data which will be Processed in a confidential manner.

6. Retention period of your Personal Data

As a general rule, certain of your Personal Data such as your biographical information, contact and travel details, information related to your participation in the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games will not be kept by Milano Cortina 2026 after the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games and by the IPC after a period of four years following the end of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games. Your Personal Data may be kept for a longer period of time where necessary to fulfil the Authorised Purposes including, without limitation, information deemed of historical interest (such as sports results, key biographical information) and information related to the compliance of activities occurring at the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games with the IPC Handbook and other rules applicable to you. Retention periods applicable to anti-doping activities are specified in the Annex A of the International Standard on Protection of Privacy and Personal Information, forming part of the World Anti-Doping Code, which provides that Personal Data of Participants may be retained over time by WADA and the



IPC, including, for some data, for a period up to 10 years which can be extended or modified where required by law or for the purpose of conducting an anti-doping investigation or proceeding or for other purposes authorised by law.

7. Protection of your Personal Data

Milano Cortina 2026 and the IPC will use technical and organisational measures to protect your Personal Data against the risks of damage, destruction, loss or unauthorised access, in accordance with applicable laws.

8. International Transfer

Milano Cortina 2026 and the IPC will Process your Personal Data mainly in Italy where the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games take place, and in Germany where the IPC headquarters are located.

However, your Personal Data is likely to be transferred outside the European Union or the European Economic Area (EEA), either to one of the recipients of your Personal Data mentioned above in Section 5 (National Paralympic Committees, Responsible Organisations...) or through the use of processors using Processing facilities in third countries. If said third countries have not been determined to offer an adequate level of protection, transfers are subject to appropriate safeguards (such as the European Commission standard contractual clauses or derogations under article 49 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 or applicable data protection laws).

9. Your rights over your Personal Data

You have the following rights over your Personal Data:

- The right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not your Personal Data are being Processed and, when it is the case, the right to access these Personal Data, as well as the right to obtain more information on the Processing;
- The right to rectify inaccurate Personal Data;
- In certain specific cases, the right to obtain the erasure of certain Personal Data;
- The right to restrict Processing in some cases;
- In certain cases, the right to object to the Processing of your Personal Data, for reasons relating to your particular situation, or, the right to object to the use of your Personal Data for marketing purposes where such activity is based on legitimate interest;
- The right to withdraw your consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of the Processing if it is based on your consent, with regard to Processing or data transfers that are subject to your consent;
- The right to receive the Personal Data you have provided and/or the right to ask to transmit them to another controller, if the Processing is based on your consent or on a contract and the Processing is automated;

We remind you that Milano Cortina 2026 or the IPC may, in accordance with the regulations, be required to refuse to grant certain requests concerning some of these rights (in particular the right of erasure), for legitimate reasons such as the need to defend legal claims or the requirements of a legal obligation to retain certain data.

Capture and use of images and contents for the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games

1. Definitions

For the purpose of this document, capitalized terms not defined herein have the meaning set forth in the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games 2026 Accreditation Terms and Conditions.

2. Capture and use of images

Accredited Persons may be filmed, photographed, identified and/or otherwise recorded at the occasion of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games. Images and/or sounds of Accredited Persons taken at this occasion may be used together with related information as part of the media coverage of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games, or otherwise to inform the public about the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games in general and promote the Paralympic Movement.

Accredited Persons understand that as participants in the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games, they will be participating in an exceptional and public event which has ongoing international and historical significance. In consideration of the acceptance of their participation, Accredited Persons agree to be filmed, photographed, identified and/or otherwise recorded during the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games by the IPC, Milano Cortina 2026 or any third party authorised by the IPC or Milano Cortina 2026 and that the resulting filmed, photographed or recorded audio-visual materials (together with their names, likenesses, voices, performances and biographical information) may be used and/or distributed (including by reproducing, distributing, communicating to the public and making it available) in any content and through any media, format or technology whether now existing or created in the future, without compensation (financial or otherwise), for the maximum duration permitted by applicable law, by Milano Cortina 2026, the IPC's Affiliates, and/or third parties authorised by them, such as Organising Committees for the Paralympic Games, National Paralympic Committees, International Sports Federations, the Marketing Partners (and media rights holders), domestic partners, news media organisations or social media platforms, during and after the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games in relation to the preparation, operation, celebration and direct or indirect promotion of, or reference to, the Paralympic Games, the Paralympic Movement, and/or the IPC and its activities, in a commercial or non-commercial context, but excluding any use that, without his/her separate written consent, will represent through use of his/her image alone that (i) there is a contractual or commercial relationship or connection between the Accredited Person and any third party or (ii) that the Accredited Person endorses or promotes a product or service of any third party.

If Accredited Person is a minor or does not have legal capacity, or in any case, under 18 years old, under the laws applicable in his/her country of residence, this authorisation is given by the holder of parental authority or the holder of a power of attorney or equivalent, in his or her own name, on behalf of the Accredited Person and that of any co-holder of parental authority or power of attorney, and with the consent of his or her child or his or her donor, depending on his or her age, degree of maturity and capacity.

Accredited Persons acknowledge that the IPC holds various exclusive rights in the Paralympic Games (including the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games), and, as the case may be, author's rights and trademarks rights. Accredited Persons understand that such exclusive rights prohibit the commercial exploitation and the marking available to the public of photographs, sound recordings or videos of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games by any individual or entity not expressly authorised to do so by the IPC and/or Milano Cortina 2026.

3. Capture and use of content

Accredited Persons may take or record still and moving images and/or sounds within the perimeter of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games' areas and venues where the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games and related events occur, as designated by Milano Cortina 2026 "**Games Areas**") for their personal, private, non-commercial and non-promotional use, subject to compliance with the IPC Digital Media Guidelines. To the extent permitted by applicable laws, Accredited Persons agree that the IPC shall be the exclusive owner of



any intellectual property rights (including copyright) in such content for the sole purpose of enforcing these rights against unauthorised exploitations of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games without further authorisation from, or payment or compensation to, the Accredited Persons or anyone acting on their behalf, and Accredited Persons hereby assign any rights they may have in respect of such content to the IPC. For clarity, "E Accredited Media" (as defined in the News Access Rules applicable during the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games) are excluded from the copyright assignment and license terms included in the PIAC, in respect of images, created within, or from, a competitive venue of the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games, exclusively when acting in a Media Capacity.

To the extent permitted by applicable laws, Accredited Persons hereby agree to waive or not to exercise any moral rights they may have in respect of such content against Milano Cortina 2026, the IPC and any third parties authorized by them, including without limitation the right to make derivative works or to modify the content. Pursuant to the above, Accredited Persons acknowledge that the IPC hereby grants them with a limited and revocable license to use the still and moving images and/or sounds that Accredited Persons take or record within the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games Areas, provided that such use is personal, private, non-commercial and non-promotional and that otherwise complies with any additional IPC requirements (including the IPC Digital Media Guidelines).

Accredited Persons acknowledge that they are solely responsible for the use of these still and moving images and thereafter, Accredited Persons release Milano Cortina 2026, the IPC, the IPC's Affiliates, and any third parties authorised by them (and their respective members, directors, officers, employees, volunteers, contractors or agents) from any responsibility in connection with them. Accredited Persons understand that, in case of breach of the IPC Digital Media Guidelines and/or any other rules or guidelines regarding the recording or making available of content, the IPC shall be entitled to take any action in order to remedy such infringement.

Accredited Persons are prohibited from (i) taking pictures and videos and from recording audio or making any other recordings in any "Photography Prohibited Area" designated in the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games Areas and its surrounding areas, as well as in any other restricted areas designated by Milano Cortina 2026, the IPC or any other authorised person, (ii) collecting, disseminating, transmitting, or publishing any scores, statistics or other information related to the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games taking place within the Milano Cortina 2026 Paralympic Winter Games Areas for any commercial, betting or gambling purpose.
