1.4.- Rules and Regulations

Competitions will be conducted in accordance with the current ISSF and WSPS Rules and Regulations. For more information, check the websites:

- WSPS Technical: www.paralympic.org/shooting/rules
- ISSF Rules and Regulations: www.issf-sports.org/theiss/rules_and_regulations.ashx

WSPS Juries (competition juries) will be appointed by the WSPS to supervise the development of the 5th Para Sport Shooting Open. Qualified ISSF/WSPS licensed range officials will conduct the competitions.

1.5.- Events Availability

Individual classification events will be carried out with the total number of registered athletes. The finals will be considered viable if there are at least 5 athletes. It will be allowed to join two categories of the same class to be able to hold a final.

The 5th Para Sports Shooting Open “Club Internacional Arequipa” will award **“Minimum Qualification Score” (MQS)** endorsed by the WSPS for the scheduled events.

1.6.- Athletes Functional Classification

An International Classification will be held on July 10th and 11th. A detailed schedule will be sent by WSPS upon completion of registration.

At least three (3) weeks prior to qualification, the athlete must have completed and uploaded to the SDMS profile the following forms can be found on the WSPS website:

- IPC medical information and
- Classification consent form

1.7.- Technical Meeting

The Rifle and Pistol Technical Meeting will take place on July 10, 2026 at 1:00 p.m. in the VIP room of the Arequipa International Club. Each Participating Federation and/or National Paralympic Committee must have at least one representative at the technical meeting.

1.8.- Award Ceremonies

The awards ceremonies will take place at the end of the day's events in the awards park in front of the 10m shooting range

During the award ceremonies, athletes must appear wearing their national uniform. You are requested to bring a National Flag (100cm x 150cm) for the award ceremonies.

1.9.- Equipment Control

Equipment control will be conducted according to WSPS rules and ISSF rules, using appropriate and calibrated instruments. All athletes must pass the equipment control of shooting jackets and wheelchairs, SH2 athletes must control balance, spring and wheelchair. All athletes must have their BID number to pass the equipment control

2. REGISTRATION PROCESS

2.1.- Eligible Athletes

Athletes from:

- National Paralympic Committees, Associations and/or federations affiliated with the World Shooting Para Sports – WSPS,
- Clubs affiliated to the National Para Sports Shooting Federations
- Possess an active WSPS License valid for the 2025 season.
- The number of individual participants per delegation is free.

2.1.- Entries and Registrations process

All athletes must be registered by their Federation and/or Paralympic committee; or by your club affiliated with the Federation or Paralympic committee.

2.3.- Late Registrations

Late registrations will only be considered if they are received at least two weeks before the official day of arrival, in order to comply with the provisions of temporary entry of weapons and ammunition of the **Sucamec** authorities (weapons control).

2.4.- Entry Fees

All payments will be made in US\$ American dollars.

It can be paid in cash at the Club Internacional cash desks.

If you wish to make the payment via bank transfer, be sure to deposit the full amount including taxes and bank fees. You can request the Club's bank account from the Organizing Committee.

Hotel payments will be made directly with them.

If any athlete or team cancels their participation after the weapons entry process has begun, they must pay the full cost of the permit.

3. ENTRY PERMIT FOR WEAPONS - ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORT

3.1.- Guns and Ammunition

Temporary Entry Permit for weapons and Ammunition

At the request of the competent authority **SUCAMEC**, they must obtain a permit for the temporary importation of weapons and ammunition before their arrival in Peru.

The document is issued by the Interior Ministry of Perú, after presenting the following documents:

- Fill out and send **annex 2** before the deadline to complete the process.
- A form (Annex 2) will be sent **for each weapon**, fill it out legibly.
- Attach the scanned copy of the passport.
- Attach the scanned copy of the valid license to use and/or carry weapons.
- Attach the scanned copy of the property card or similar document issued by the competent authority of your country of origin. In case an athlete travels with the arms of his federation, he must attach the corresponding document of the federation.
- Send the travel itinerary, including the name of the airline, flight number, day and time of arrival to Lima and departure from Lima to your country

The Organizing Committee will not be responsible to the airport police, for any wrong information sent, of air weapons, firearms and/or ammunition.

All delegations must request information from the airlines on the transport of weapons before buying their air tickets.

Within Peru, they will be able to travel with the entry permits that will be processed with annex 2

Ammunition cannot be transported in a Carry-on bag; it must go in checked baggage.

Once they arrive in the city of Arequipa, all the weapons will be transported from the airport to the shooting range by a person in charge; and, in the same way, from the shooting range to the airport.

When purchasing national tickets, delegations should consider enough time (4 hours minimum) to be able to go through customs, Sucamec and immigration controls, especially for the return flight.

3.2.- Accommodation

3.2.- Food Services

If you do not want to take the food service at the shooting range; The Arequipa International Club offers different food offers, such as restaurants and fast food establishments, with prices from US\$5 to US\$25 per dish.

3.3.- Transportation

The Official Airport of arrival in Lima is the Jorge Chávez International Airport, there you must take a national flight to the city of Arequipa that lasts an hour and a half.

The Official Airport of Arequipa is the Rodríguez Ballón International Airport.

The distance from the airport to the hotel's zone is 25 minutes

The mobility service of the organizing committee covers transportation from the airport to the official hotels and from the hotels to the airport, as well as daily mobility from the hotel to the shooting range and from the shooting range to the hotel.

The cost of the taxi service from the airport to the furthest hotel is approximately US\$ 20.00, this services is not covered by the organization committee

Remember: minimum connection time on domestic flights is 4 hours minimum before your flight due to the airline's weapons registration.
