




Accommodation Payment

Visa process

1. NPC to send to LOC the Visa Form template completed with all participants' information before 18 February 2026.
2. LOC to prepare and send to the NPC the Visa Invitation Letter.
3. NPC to make the necessary arrangements depending on the Visa needs for their country (i.e. e-visa procedures, embassy appointment, etc.).
4. NPC to inform the LOC and WPPO when they receive the visa.

8. Host City



About Bangkok

Bangkok is the capital and most populous city of Thailand. It serves as the nation's main centre of development, both domestically and within Southeast Asia.

The city is located near the mouth of the Chao Phraya River, which flows through the urban centre and divides it into two main areas: the Phra Nakhon side and the Thonburi side.

The city covers 1,568.737 square kilometres and in 2024 had a population of around 10 million, accounting for about 13% of Thailand's total population. Including the surrounding metropolitan area, the population rises to roughly 17 million, giving Bangkok the status of a metropolis and a primate city, meaning it is significantly more influential than any other city in the country.

Bangkok is a city that seamlessly blends culture, history, and modern life. Visitors can explore historic temples such as Wat Phra Kaew, Wat Arun, and Wat Pho; shop at modern malls and vibrant markets like Chatuchak and Yaowarat or Chinatown; relax in green spaces such as Lumpini Park; and experience art and culture at the Bangkok Art and Culture Centre

Top Recommended Places:

- Wat Arun – a must-visit riverside temple famous for its stunning prang.
- The Grand Palace – Thailand's most magnificent royal landmark.
- In mid-April, visitors can experience the Songkran Festival, especially on Silom Road and Khao San Road, where the streets come alive with water celebrations, music, and festivities

General Information

IPC Membership

The Organising Committee will only accept entries submitted by the NPC / NF in good standing with the IPC. Furthermore, only those entries submitted by the NPC President, Secretary General, or authorised person will be processed. For further information on the IPC's membership policies or to address general membership issues, please contact the World Para Powerlifting (WPPO) office: info@WorldParaPowerlifting.org

World Para Powerlifting Rules and Regulations

The most current World Para Powerlifting Rules and Regulations published upon the WPPO website alongside the World Para Powerlifting Qualification Pathway 2025-2028 will apply for this Championships.

Anti-doping


The Anti-Doping control / processes will be carried out in full accordance with the IPC Anti-Doping Code and the IPC Doping Control Agreement, further details can be found on the WPPO website: www.paralympic.org/powerlifting/rules-and-regulations/anti-doping

Classification

The most current World Para Powerlifting Classification Rules and Regulations published upon the WPPO website will apply for this World Championships. All athletes who have a designated sport class status of New, Review, Review 2026 or earlier will be required to undergo International Classification prior to the start of the Championships. A detailed classification schedule will follow after the revision of the final entries by WPPO.

Medical information

The LOC will ensure the implementation of all necessary and appropriate on-site medical, emergency ambulance, first aid, and physiotherapeutic services throughout the Championships. For medical treatment, no medical insurances will be provided to any participant during the Championships.



Participant Insurance

Each respective NPC is fully responsible to ensure that all members of their delegation are appropriately insured, including coverage for travel, medical, liability, accidents, Covid 19 and repatriation. Each NPC will need to provide evidence of appropriate insurance coverage for their full delegation by no later than 24 March 2026.

Bodyweight Changes

Athletes will have the opportunity to change Bodyweight Categories during the entry verification process, either up or down one (1) Bodyweight Category from the category assigned at the time of the final entry deadline.

Only one (1) change per Athlete is accepted and must be requested during the allocated time of the entry verification process. A fee of one hundred Euros (€100) will be charged for each requested change and must be paid immediately during the entry verification process for the change to be accepted. The new Bodyweight Category is accepted only upon payment and is considered final.


Lift Challenge Cards

At WPPO Regional Open Championships, Athletes will have the opportunity to challenge their own “No Lift” decision. The Lift Challenge cards must be requested from the entries open date until the Teams Meeting date at a cost of one hundred Euros (€100). Full payment must be paid immediately upon request of the Lift Challenge card/s. Any purchased Lift Challenge cards retained by an Athlete or Team Official must be returned to the WPPO management before the close of the Championships in order to receive a full refund. Any Lift Challenge cards that are not returned in this timeframe will no longer be valid or eligible for a refund.

Bodyweight Changes & Lift Challenge Card Payment

WPPO has established 2 payment methods:

Preliminary Programme

The Provisional timetable and events programme will be provided after the final entries by name deadline. The competition schedule will remain subject to change until the close of the technical meeting.

There is no maximum number of entries per gender, Bodyweight Category and age group per NPC.


Team events (Gender and Mixed)

In accordance with the most current World Para Powerlifting Technical Rules and Regulations published upon the WPPO website.

Event Viability

Athletes may compete and/or be awarded medals in a single Bodyweight Category or combined categories as detailed below:

- 3 or more Athletes: All medals will be awarded (Gold, Silver, Bronze).
- MS rule: when there is one (1) athlete in a single bodyweight category, and they lift equal to or more than the respective level MS for that bodyweight category as published in the Appendix 10 (Gold).



Entries and Registration Process

In order for athlete entries to be accepted, they must meet the following criteria and deadlines:

Athlete Eligibility

- Be full registered on the IPC Sport Management System (SDMS) with the correct documentation (IPC Eligibility Form and Medical Diagnostic Form) completed fully signed, and uploaded to the athlete profile;
- Have an active license for the 2026 Season;
- Be a minimum of 15 year of age by 31 December 2026;
- Have an international classification status of New, Review, Review + Fixed Date or Confirmed

NOTE: There is no required Minimum Standard (MS) to enter the Bangkok 2026 Asia-Oceania Open Championships.

Entries and Registration Process


All Championship entries must be completed via the IPC Online entry system at <https://db.ipc-services.org/sdms/app/login> by the entry deadlines displayed below. Visa invitations, accommodation applications, accreditation applications, and travel information must be submitted by no later than the deadlines published below.

Late entries

Team must contact the WPPO office if there is a late entry request. All respective information provided by the NPC/NF will be reviewed in consultation with the LOC on a 'case by case' basis and the entry may be accepted/rejected accordingly by WPPO.

Replacements

The WPPO office must be informed if an NPC/NF needs to make a replacement. The replacement of athletes may be accepted due to injury or medical reasons. All respective supporting information regarding the replacement must be sent to the WPPO office and will be reviewed on a 'case by case' bases and accepted/rejected accordingly by WPPO.



Declaration of Participation

By completing and submitting sport entries, NPCs are considered to have officially declared the participation of their athletes in the specified events/categories.

Final Entry Process

- All entries by number must be completed by 24 February 2026 and all final entries by name must be completed by 3 March 2026.
- Please note that after this deadline no changes to the final entries and or final team delegation be accepted unless under exceptional circumstances.
- Please note that any decisions concerning this matter will be made by WPPO and are not open for further contest or appeal by any other organization or body.
- Changes of bodyweight category after 3 March 2026 will only be possible during the verification process. No change will be possible after the Teams Meeting.

Random Weigh-in

According to the WPPO Rules and Regulations Random Weigh – ins of the Athletes may take place in the day of the Event in advance of the warm-up for the specific Bodyweight Category at the discretion of WPPO.

Should an Athlete weight outside of percentage of their specific Bodyweight Category they will be disqualified (DSQ) from the Event.

The percentage is set to 5% of the specific Bodyweight Category, detailed on the table on the right.


After the close of the Championship the official Championship results book(s) will be compiled, and it will be posted and uploaded to the World Para Powerlifting website.
