General Information

Changwon 2026 WSPS World Championships

07 – 16 September 2026



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1 Introduction

Korea Shooting Federation for Disabled (KSFD), Korea Paralympic Committee (KPC) and World Shooting Para Sport (WSPS) are pleased to invite you to the Changwon 2026 WSPS World Championships.

The Competition will be held at Changwon International Shooting Range in Changwon, Gyeongsangnam-do, Republic of Korea from 07 to 16 September 2026.

The Competition will be a Full Programme Competition, featuring rifle, pistol, shotgun and vision impaired events, and will serve as a 2028 LA Paralympic Quota Allocation event.

1.1 Organisation and Administration

1.2 Host City Information

Changwon is a city of approximately 1 million people located in Gyeongsangnam-do on the southeastern coast of the Republic of Korea. Changwon International Shooting Range is a world-class shooting venue that has successfully hosted events including the 2018 ISSF World Championships and consecutive WSPS World Cup competitions since 2022.



2 Competition Information

2.1 Dates of Competition

The Changwon 2026 WSPS World Championships will feature a full programme of rifle, pistol, shotgun and vision impaired events (R1~R9, P1~P5, PT1~PT3, VIS, VIP).

2.2 Technical Meeting

The Rifle & Pistol Technical Meeting will take place on 9 September 2026 at 15:00 at the Finals Hall. The Shotgun Technical Meeting will be announced separately.

Each participating WSPS Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding final schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the Competition.

2.3 Event Information

2.3.1 Opening / Closing Ceremonies

The Opening Ceremony will take place on 9 September 2026 at 17:00 at the Competition Venue.

The Closing Ceremony will take place on 15 September 2026. Detailed schedule and venue will be



announced at the Technical Meeting.

2.3.2 Victory Ceremony

The Victory Ceremonies will take place at the Competition Venue immediately after the end of each Final. The detailed ceremony schedule will be announced separately. During the ceremonies, athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

2.4 Venue

- 50m Range: 80 Electronic Targets
- 25m Range: 70 Electronic Targets
- 10m Range: 99 Electronic Targets
- Final Hall: 10 Electronic Targets for each distance

Para Trap will use 3-5 ranges equipped with Matarelli machines and Progetti Electronic System.

2.5 Competition Period

The competition period has been calculated based on the minimum number of competition days plus two (2) additional days for Equipment Control and Training.

2.6 Rules and Regulations

The Competition will be conducted under WSPS Rules and Regulations and ISSF Rules and Regulations, as well as the WSPS Classification Rules.

2.7 Equipment Control

2.7.1 Rifle & Pistol Equipment Control

Equipment Control will be conducted according to WSPS Rules and ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. The tag is only for ISSF clothes and rifle.

All athletes must pass the Equipment Control for the wheelchair and all SH2 athletes must control the balance and the spring.

All athletes must carry their BIB number during Equipment Control.

2.7.2 Shotgun Equipment Control

The Shotgun Equipment Control schedule will be announced separately.

2.8 Eligibility Criteria

2.8.1 Athlete Eligibility

All athletes must meet the following criteria to participate in this Competition:

1. Hold a valid 2026 WSPS License
2. Have an International Classification status of Confirmed (C) or Review (R) 2026 or later.
3. Have achieved a Minimum Qualification Score (MQS) for the event(s) entered at a WSPS-recognised competition

2.8.2 Minimum Qualification Scores (MQS)

Athletes must have achieved the Minimum Qualification Score at least once between 01 January 2025 and 15 August 2026 for the event(s) they wish to enter. Athletes who have achieved MQS in multiple events may enter all events for which they have qualified.

2.8.3 Minimum Qualification Score Standards

The MQS standards for each event are as follows:

2.9 Maximum Number of Athlete Entries per NPC per Event

The maximum number of entries per NPC is four (4) athletes per event. For single-gender events such as P1, P2, R1, R2, R7 and R8, one must be a junior to enter four (4) athletes; if no junior athlete is entered, the maximum number of entries is three (3).

In mixed events, the maximum number of entries per NPC is four (4) if one is a female or junior. If no female or junior athlete is entered, the maximum number of entries is three (3).



NPCs may enter a maximum of two (2) mixed teams per mixed team event.

2.10 Vision Impaired Events

Athletes competing in the Vision Impaired events must bring their own LED lights for target attachment.

2.11 Results, Rankings & Records

After the competition is finished, results will be reviewed and published on the WSPS website and the Ranking and Records lists will be updated accordingly. All athletes participating in the World Championships must have achieved MQS and have completed Classification.

2.12 2028 LA Paralympic Quota Allocation

Quotas for the 2028 LA Paralympic Games will be allocated at this Competition. For further information, see the WSPS website and LA 2028 Qualification Regulations:

2.13 Viability of Events

Individual events are considered viable if there are athletes from a minimum of four (4) countries entered through the Entry by Name. One set of medals (gold, silver, bronze) will be awarded.

Team events will be considered viable if a minimum of three (3) eligible NPCs have entered teams through the Entry by Name. In cases where only three (3) teams participate, medals will be awarded to the first and second place only.

Mixed team events will be considered viable if a minimum of four (4) eligible NPCs have entered teams through the Entry by Name.

If an event fails to meet the above minimum viability criteria, it will not be considered viable and will be cancelled.

2.14 International Classification

International Classification will not be conducted at the World Championships. All athletes must have completed Classification prior to the Competition.



2.15 Doping Control

Doping control will be conducted according to the IPC Anti-Doping Code. The controls will be made by Korea Anti-Doping Agency (KADA).

3 Registration Process

3.1 Entry Registration

All athletes must be entered by their respective NPCs or organisation authorised by WSPS and accepted by WSPS.

All NPCs must submit their entries by the registration deadlines. Even if an athlete intends to achieve MQS during the entry period, the entry for that athlete must be submitted within the deadline.

3.2 Late Entries

Late Entry Requests (submitted after the Final Entry by Name deadline) will only be considered if they are received by WSPS at least two (2) weeks before the Official Arrival Day for the Korea Police to arrange the permits.

Such entries may be accepted through the LOC or WSPS; however, a Late Entry Fee of EUR 100 will be charged per additional event entered.

3.3 Entry Changes

Replacement Entries may be accepted in the same event only due to injury or medical reason. The NPC must submit a valid medical report to WSPS for approval.

3.4 Accreditation

All persons participating in this Competition (athletes, team officials, WSPS officials, LOC officials, media, etc.) must be accredited and must wear their accreditation badge at all times.

Accreditation will be prepared by the LOC and WSPS. Accreditation badges and BIB numbers will be distributed by the LOC upon confirmation of full payment of participation fees.

All accreditation information must be entered in SDMS.



3.5 Media

Media representatives must submit the Media Accreditation Form. A dedicated media working area will be set up at the venue; however, capacity is limited. Please contact the LOC in advance for arrangements.

4 Participation Fees

4.1 Entry Fees (Payable to WSPS)

Entry Fees are not payable to the LOC but must be paid directly to WSPS via the SDMS-generated invoice.

5 Accommodation & Transportation

5.1 Official Hotel

The official accommodation is the i-Square Hotel Gimhae located at 2360, Gimhae-daero, Gimhae-si, Gyeongsangnam-do and the Grand Mercure Ambassador Changwon Hotel located at 332, Woni-daero, Changwon-si, Gyeongsangnam-do. All participants will be accommodated at these hotels.

A minimum of five (5) nights must be booked for accommodation.

Accommodation fees must be paid to the LOC.

Hotel check-in time is 15:00 and check-out time is 12:00 (noon). Please note that accommodation fees are non-refundable.

For any arrivals before the Official Arrival Day, please contact the LOC in advance to arrange accommodation.

All delegations must stay at the official hotels only.

5.2 Catering

All meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) will be provided to participants. Breakfast and dinner will be served at the official hotel, and lunch will be provided at the shooting range.

In case of any food allergies, dietary restrictions, or specific food preferences, please contact the LOC via email.

5.3 Transportation

The LOC is willing to organise and provide convenience for every delegation as much as possible. The LOC has organised the following transportation options for delegations:

Option 1. Incheon Airport (ICN)/Gimhae Airport (PUS) → Ground vehicle → Direct to Changwon. Takes 5 hours from Incheon, 1 hour 30 minutes from Gimhae. Cost: USD 280 per person.

Option 2. Incheon Airport (ICN) → Domestic airline → Gimhae Airport (PUS) → Ground vehicle.



Takes 2 hours 30 minutes total from ICN to Changwon. Cost: USD 450 per person.

NOTE: All transportation between Airport ↔ Accommodation ↔ Shooting Range is included in the transportation fee. Firearms transportation is also included.

The LOC will operate a daily shuttle bus service between the shooting range and official hotels during the competition period. The shuttle buses are wheelchair accessible.

6 Firearms and Ammunition

6.1 Firearms Import/Export

All delegations must complete the Firearms Import/Export Form and submit it by the registration deadline (31 July 2026).

Please check and submit the following documents:

- Firearms Import/Export Form (individual form, one per firearm)
- Copy of passport
- Copy of firearms permit
- Copy of possession permit (if not the firearm owner)
- Flight information: airline name, flight number, departure and arrival dates and times

IMPORTANT: Any request to change firearms details after the submission of the Firearms Import/Export Form will not be accepted.

6.2 Flights

All NPCs are responsible for arranging their own flights to the Competition. All NPCs are also requested to check with their official airline all the required documents pertaining to import/export of firearms and ammunition.

6.3 Ammunition – Rifle/Pistol/Shotgun

Ammunition is not allowed in carry-on baggage and/or with the firearm. Ammunition must be packed in a separate container from firearms.



NOTE: After the competition, re-exporting remaining ammunition is legally possible but strongly not recommended by the LOC due to the complex and cumbersome procedures involved. These ammunition will be stored in the armoury of the shooting range. Please prepare your ammunition with this in consideration.

NOTE: For shotgun ammunition, please contact the LOC (ksfd0427@gmail.com) in advance. Each NPC must contact the LOC to pre-purchase ammunition for use in Korea.

6.4 Firearms Transportation and Storage

The armoury for firearms and ammunition storage is located at the shooting range. Upon departure, all firearms will be removed from the armoury for direct transit to the airport.

The armoury will be open from the Official Arrival Day until the Official Departure Day. Any teams arriving or departing outside of these dates should advise the LOC so alternate arrangements can be made.

NOTE: All athletes are requested to put labels on their firearms cases and ammunition packages mentioning their name and NPC.



7 Other Important Information

7.1 Insurance

Please kindly note that all team members (including athletes, officials, and support staff) attending this Competition are requested to ensure they have personal, medical and travel insurance.

The LOC will not cover any illness, property damage, or other incidents related to delegations. The responsibility lies with the respective National Federations and National Paralympic Committees.

7.2 Visa

NPCs are responsible for obtaining a visa if required to enter Korea. To request an official letter of invitation from the LOC to aid with the visa application process, please contact the LOC (ksfd0427@gmail.com).

7.3 Flags and Anthems

All delegations are requested to bring their national anthem in digital format (preferably MP3; maximum length 50 seconds) and at least one (1) national flag (approx. size 150cm × 100cm).

7.4 Climate

The temperature in September in Changwon is between min. 18°C and max. 30°C. Please note that humidity tends to be high.
