<b>ATHLETE QUOTA</b>	<b>Male</b>	<b>84</b>

<b>ALLOCATION OF QUALIFICATION</b>	The qualification slot is allocated to the NPC not to the individual athlete.
<b>MAXIMUM QUOTA ALLOCATION PER NPC</b>	An NPC can be allocated a maximum of six (6) qualification slots for the men's events and five (5) for the women's events for a total of eleven (11) qualification slots.
<b>ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY</b>	To be eligible for selection by an NPC, athletes must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have competed in at least one international IBSA Judo competition between 1 January 2010 and 31 January 2012; and</li> <li>• Be internationally classified with either a 'Review' or 'Confirmed' sport class status.</li> </ul>
<b>MAXIMUM ENTRY PER NPC</b>	An NPC can enter a maximum of one (1) eligible athlete per individual event.  NPC may only enter athletes in weight categories in which they have achieved a qualification slot.



**QUALIFICATION SYSTEM PRINCIPLES**

<b>IBSA JUDO WORLD RANKING ALLOCATION</b>	The top (10) ranked male athletes on the IBSA Judo Male World Ranking List in each weight category closing 31 December 2011, will earn a qualification slot for their NPC in the corresponding weight category	70 males athletes
	The top (6 ) ranked female athletes on the IBSA Judo female World Ranking list in each weight category closing 31 December 2011, will attain a qualification slot for their NPC in the corresponding weight category	36 females athletes
<b>HOST COUNTRY ALLOCATION</b>	The host country directly qualifies one (1) athlete in each weight category for both genders, if not otherwise qualified through the 2011 IBSA Judo World Championships Allocation Method.	7 male athletes 6 female athletes
<b>BIPARTITE COMMISSION INVITATION ALLOCATION</b>	Seven (7) eligible male athletes and six (6) eligible female athletes from African Region will be considered by the IPC and IBSA for Bipartite Commission Invitation qualification slots. To be considered for a Bipartite Commission Invitation, IBSA must receive an official application in writing from the relevant NPC.	7 male athletes 6 female athletes

## QUALIFYING TIMELINE

1 January 2010	Start of the period for performances to be recorded on the 2010 IBSA Judo World Ranking Lists.
31 December 2011	End of the period for performances to be recorded on the 2011 IBSA Judo World Ranking List for possible use in the reallocation of unused qualification slots
6 February 2012	Start of Bipartite Commission Invitation application process
12 March 2012	IBSA notifies in writing to the NPCs the allocation of individual qualification slots
26 March 2012	NPCs confirm in writing to IBSA the use of allocated individual qualification slots
26 March 2012	Deadline to submit Bipartite Invitation application to IBSA
9 April 2012	IBSA confirms in writing the reallocation of unused individual qualification slots and the awarding of Bipartite Commission Invitations.
20 April 2012	Deadline for London 2012 Organizing Committee to receive accreditation application forms submitted by NPCs
6 August 2012	Deadline for London 2012 Organizing Committee to receive sport entry forms submitted by NPCs

## DATES / PROCESS OF CONFIRMATION OF QUALIFICATION SLOTS

By **26 March 2012**, each NPC must confirm to IBSA in writing (fax and e-mails are accepted) the number of qualification slots they will use. NPCs that have not replied by this date will have lost their team qualification slots, and IBSA may reallocate these slots.

By **12 March 2012**, IBSA will confirm in writing the reallocation of all unused team qualification slots.

By **12 March 2012**, it is officially declared that the respective NPCs will use the allocated quota granted for the London 2012 Paralympic Games. Any NPC that does not use some or all qualification slots allocated may be subject to sanctions by the IPC and IBSA.



## **REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION SLOTS**

Any qualification slots allocated to an NPC that are not used will be reallocated to the highest ranked and not otherwise qualified athlete in the corresponding weight category on the IBSA Judo World Ranking List closing 31 December 2011.
