ALLOCATION OF QUALIFICATION	<p>The qualification is allocated to the NPC not to the individual athlete.</p> <p>In the case of a Bipartite Commission Invitations the qualification slot is allocated to the individual athlete, not to the NPC.</p>

MAXIMUM QUOTA ALLOCATION PER NPC	An NPC can be allocated a maximum of five (5) qualification slots through the Direct Qualification Method.

2010 IPC SHOOTING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS DIRECT ALLOCATION	<p>The top two (2) ranked athletes in each medal event qualify the NPC for one (1) qualification slot.</p> <p>In the case that an athlete is ranked first or second in more than one medal event (in the current competition or in multiple competitions), they can only qualify for one (1) qualification slot for their respective NPC.</p> <p>In such case(s) the next higher ranked athlete in that medal event will qualify a qualification slot for their NPC.</p> <p>The order of priority of medal events for the direct slot allocation is: R1, R2, P3, R3, R7, R8, P4, R4, P2, R6, P1 and R5.</p>	24 male and female athletes
IPC SHOOTING WORLD CUPS DIRECT ALLOCATION	<p>Twelve (12) qualification slots will be allocated in each one of the following World Cups (Paralympic Qualifiers):</p> <p>2011 World Cup – AUS: 12 Slots 2011 World Cup - USA:12 Slots 2011 World Cup – Europe ESP: 12 Slots</p> <p>The top ranked athlete in each medal event can only qualify for one (1) qualification slot for their respective NPC.</p> <p>In the case that an athlete is ranked first in more than one medal event (in the current competition or in multiple competitions), they can only qualify for one (1) qualification slot for their respective NPC.</p>	36 male and female athletes

IPC SHOOTING WORLD CUPS DIRECT ALLOCATION (continued)	<p>In such case(s) the next higher ranked athlete in that medal event will qualify a qualification slot for their NPC.</p> <p>The order of priority of medal events for the direct slot allocation is: R1, R2, P3, R3, R7, R8, P4, R4, P2, R6, P1 and R5.</p>	
IPC SHOOTING MQS QUALIFICATION LIST ALLOCATION	<p>An IPC Shooting Paralympic Games Qualification List (hereafter referred to as “the List”) will be established with the number of slots that can be allocated by NPC and have been achieved at the 2010 IPC Shooting recognized Competitions, and 2011 IPC Shooting recognized competitions between 1 January 2010 and 31 December 2011. The List will close on 31 December 2011.</p> <p>The factor used to calculate the number of MQS qualification slots per NPC using the MQS list as of 31 December 2011 and applying the following formula:</p> $\frac{76}{TA} = R$ <p>TA = Total eligible athletes meeting the MQS – 60 Direct Slots R = NPC athlete quota ratio</p> <p>The total number of MQS Qualification Slots to be allocated to each NPC will be determined applying the following formula:</p> $TE \times R = TS$ <p>TE: Total eligible MQS athlete per NPC - number of Direct Slots for this NPC TS: Total eligible slots via MQS - number of Direct Slots</p> <p>A total of seventy six (76) slots are allocated in IPC Shooting recognized competitions.</p>	<p>76 athletes</p>



An athlete must obtain a minimum of 2 MQS results in order to be included in the final qualification list.

Once an athlete has obtained qualification (=2 MQS) for an event, only 1 MQS is necessary for an additional event.

NPC Allocation Formula:

Following the compilation of the List closing 31 December 2011, IPC Shooting will calculate the NPC qualification slot allocations through the following formulas:

Determination of overall NPC athlete quota ratio (see calculations on page 4):

Overall number of slots per NPC:

The overall number of slots per NPC is the sum of the direct slots and the final qualification slots through MQS results

$$\text{NPC DS} + \text{TS} = \text{TST}$$

NPC DS: Direct Slots allocated to this NPC

TS: Total eligible slots via MQS (- number of Direct Slots)

TST: Total of slots per NPC

	<p>The quota for NPCs having both male and female eligible athletes will be allocated through the gender representation ratio:</p> $\text{TST} \times \text{GP(M)} = \text{GR(M)}$ $\text{TST} \times \text{GP(F)} = \text{GR(F)}$ <p>TST: Total of slots per NPC GP(M) = Gender percentage; 71.421% for male ratio GP(F) = Gender percentage; 28.571% for female ratio GR(M) = Gender representation male ratio GR(F) = Gender representation female ratio</p>	

Determination of qualification slot allocation quota (per NPC):

$$GR(M) + GR(F) + RS = TST(M/F)$$

RS = remaining slots

TST(M/F) = Total qualification slot allocation quota for NPC with male and female athletes

The gender based slots through direct qualification are included in the calculation. Should the gender allocation not assign all slots to a given gender, the remaining slot(s) shall be distributed at the discretion of the respective NPC.

The quota for NPCs having only eligible male or only eligible female athletes will be allocated 100% for athletes in the respective gender.

The above mentioned method does not apply for NPCs with a total of up to five (5) eligible athletes as the gender representation ratio cannot be implemented. Those NPCs will be allocated gender-free slots according to their total number of slots that can be allocated based on the NPC allocation formula.

QUALIFYING TIMELINE

1 January 2010	Start of period for athletes to attain performances for ranking on the Paralympic Games Shooting Qualification List
	Start of the period for athletes to achieve MQS performances
31 December 2011	Closing of the Qualification List (“the List”) which will be established with the number of slots that can be allocated by NPC.
15 January 2012	IPC Shooting publishes the Paralympic Games Shooting Qualification List and distributes it to the NPCs
6 February 2012	Start of Bipartite Commission Invitation NPC application process
12 March 2012	IPC Shooting confirms in writing to the NPCs the allocation of qualification slots
26 March 2012	NPCs confirm to IPC Shooting in writing the use of allocated qualification slots
	Deadline to submit Bipartite Invitation application to IPC Shooting
9 April 2012	IPC Shooting confirms in writing the reallocation of unused qualification slots
	IPC Shooting confirms in writing to NPCs the awarding of Bipartite Commission Invitations
20 April 2012	Deadline for London 2012 Organizing Committee to receive accreditation application forms submitted by NPCs
1 June 2012	End of the period for athletes to achieve MQS performances
6 August 2012	Deadline for London 2012 Organizing Committee to receive sport entry forms submitted by NPCs



DATES / PROCESS OF CONFIRMATION OF QUALIFICATION SLOTS

By 26 March 2012, each NPC must confirm to the IPC Shooting in writing (fax and e-mail are accepted) the number of qualification slots they will use. NPCs that have not replied by this date will have lost their qualification slots, and the IPC Shooting may reallocate these slots.

By 9 April 2012, IPC Shooting will confirm in writing the reallocation of all unused qualification slots.

By 9 April 2012, it is officially declared that the respective NPC's will use the allocated quota granted for the London 2012 Paralympic Games. Any NPC that does not use some or all of the qualification slots allocated may be subject to sanctions by the IPC.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION SLOTS

Any qualification slots that are not used by an NPC will be reallocated through the Bipartite Commission Invitation allocation method.
