



Tickets are made available subject to the following terms & conditions:

1. No alcohol will be permitted to be brought into the arena.
2. Persons will not be admitted if, in the opinion of the stewards, they are under the influence of alcohol or an illegal substance.
3. The event takes place on a greenfield site and the ground may be uneven. There may be temporary roadways and ramps. Please take care when walking on and off the roads and ramps or crossing them in wheelchairs or children's buggies.
4. Re-entry will not be permitted during any session.
5. Tickets cannot be exchanged or refunded in whole or in part. For the avoidance of doubt, if a Ticket holder chooses not to use a ticket for a particular session no refund will be given.
6. In the interest of fraud protection, no tickets will be replaced or ticket prices refunded if a ticket is forgotten, lost, stolen, defaced, damaged or otherwise unavailable.
7. In all events we reserve the right to refuse entry to any person, or to remove any person from the venue, where in our reasonable opinion we believe that person may cause a risk to the safety or security of the session or the enjoyment of the session by others.
8. Swansea 2014 regulations may change over time and the regulations which apply shall be those which are in force at the time at which you attend.
9. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
10. In the interests of safety, please do not bring glass items, barbecues, candles or flaming torches.
11. Please be aware that smoke effects, strobe lighting, lasers and loud noises may be used at the event.
12. A security search may be carried out.
13. Swansea 2014 reserves the right to refuse admission to any person at its own discretion.
14. Swansea 2014 reserves the right to make any alteration to the advertised schedule.
15. Ticket holders must comply with all directions given by Swansea 2014 personnel and stewards whilst at the venue.



16. Ticket holders release Swansea 2014 from any liability for any loss or damage to personal property that may be suffered in relation to the event. Except as required by law.
17. Tickets may not be resold (including by way of auction) nor advertised for sale. Tickets may not be used for advertising, promotion, fundraising or marketing purposes (including in competitions, contests and sweepstakes).
18. Ticket holders understand that the arrangements for the event may be affected by circumstances beyond the control of the organisers, which may result in the delay, postponement or cancellation of the event without notice. Swansea 2014 organisers shall have no liability to ticket holders in respect of such delay, postponement or cancellation.
19. Ticket holders consent to being filmed, photographed and recorded and understand that photographs, films or recordings of ticket holders may be broadcast, published, licensed or used in perpetuity (without payment).
20. Ticket holders agree that any personal images, videos, or sound recordings taken at the event may only be used for private and domestic purposes and cannot be used for any commercial purposes, whether on the internet or otherwise.
21. Swansea 2014 shall have the right to copy, make available and use any images, videos or audio recordings that Ticket holders create as seen fit, without having to make any payment or acknowledgment that the Ticket holder created that material.
22. No commercial or promotional / advertising / marketing activity may be undertaken at or near the venue.
23. Ticket holders may not engage in any activity which the organisers consider to be related to unauthorised marketing or advertising (this includes, for the avoidance of doubt, individual or group ambush marketing). Swansea 2014 reserves the right to refuse admission to or eject from the premises any person who fails to comply with this restriction.
