Grand Prix (GP) Ranking

A dedicated ranking of those 20 events shall be established for the athletes who compete at the eight (9) 2015 IPC Athletics Grand Prix competitions.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the GP rankings, an athlete must:

- hold an active IPC Athlete's license of the 2015 season;
- have achieved a performance at one of the nine(9) 2015 IPC Athletics Grand Prix Competition in accordance with the Athlete Licensing Programme Policy valid for the 2015 Season;
- have been internationally classified with a "**Review**" or "**Confirmed**" sport class status.

Guide-runners must hold an active IPC Athlete's license of the 2015 season to be eligible to enter and compete at the final.

Qualification

Direct qualification slots shall be given to the top 6 ranked athletes of each event featuring in the Grand Prix rankings. In the event of an unused/returned slot, it will go to the next top ranked athlete of the GP ranking of that event.

Two (2) additional invitational slots will be distributed at the discretion of IPC Athletics to ensure top athletes to perform at the final and achieve greater representation by nation and/or region.

Logistics

For qualified/invited athletes:

- The LOC will cover the transport (including air and ground transport on arrival), accommodation and meals.

For Guide-runners

- The LOC will cover the accommodation, meals and transport for a maximum of one (1) guide-runner per VI track athlete under the same provision of the accompanying athlete.

For Team Officials/coaches/guides for Field events

- The cost of accommodation, meals and transport shall be borne by themselves.

Prize

The IPC Athletics Grand Prix final has a prize fund. The amount and structure will be made available at a later date.

In the event a NPC does not respect the above confirmation timelines, its qualification slots shall be deemed returned to IPC Athletics for reallocation and the athletes from this NPC shall be not considered for reallocation.

IPC Athletics reserves the right to replace athletes that withdraw after 29 June (deadline for acceptance of direct qualification and/or invitational slots) with athletes of its choosing.
