2 Athlete eligibility

2.1 Athletes must:

- Hold a valid IPCAS Licence for 2016/2017 season, and have achieved race points in one race of the 2016/2017 season.
- Be at least sixteen (16) years old by 31 December 2016.
- Be internationally classified with either a '**Confirmed**' sport class status or a '**Review 2017**' sport class status or later.

For technical events:

Slalom

- Be ranked and have for the Men 240 IPCAS points or less and for the Women 280 IPCAS points or less on the IPCAS Slalom Ranking List as of 10 January 2017.

- Be ranked and have for the Men 240 IPCAS points or less and for the Women 280 IPCAS points or less on the IPCAS Giant Slalom Ranking List as of 10 January 2017.

For speed events:

- Be ranked and have for the Men 140 IPCAS points or less in DH or SG and for the Women 180 IPCAS points or less in DH or SG on the IPCAS DH or SG Ranking List as of 10 January 2017.

3 NPC Delegation quota formula

NPCs will be allowed to enter the following number of staff per athlete:

For 2 athletes	1 Staff, plus VI Guides
From 3 to 5 athletes	4 Staff, plus VI Guides
From 6 to 10 athletes	8 Staff, plus VI Guides
Above 10 athletes 1 additional staff to every 2 athletes (rounded up)	
Extra Staff: Chef de Mission and one (1) Team Doctor
