World Shooting Para Sport International Judge



License	ISSF Judge A or B License holder
Course	Participation at an World Shooting Para Sport Judges Course, followed by an examination.
Levels	<p>World Shooting Para Sport <u>C</u> Level Judge Following the successful completion of an World Shooting Para Sport Judges Course and examination, a certificate will be sent by World Shooting Para Sport. Certified C Level Judges may request to World Shooting Para Sport to attend an World Shooting Para Sport recognised competition (at their own cost) for supervision by World Shooting Para Sport A/B Level International Judges and upgrade assessment.</p> <p>World Shooting Para Sport <u>B</u> Level International Judge Certified C Level Judges can be upgraded to B Level International Judge by working in an appropriate role for at least one (1) World Shooting Para Sport recognised competition under the supervision of an World Shooting Para Sport A or B Level Judge. C Level Judges will attend competitions at their own expense. The supervising World Shooting Para Sport A/B Level Judge will submit to World Shooting Para Sport a Progress Report after the competition, and if approved by World Shooting Para Sport, the Judge will be upgraded from C to B Level.</p> <p>World Shooting Para Sport <u>A</u> Level International Judge Certified B Level International Judges can be upgraded to World Shooting Para Sport A Level International Judges after acquiring experience over a number of years:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ He/she must be an active ISSF Senior International Referee (A) for at least four (4) years ▪ He/she must have the ISSF EST-License (Electronic-Scoring-Target-License) ▪ Must have attended at least five (5) World Shooting Para Sport recognised competitions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ On at least two occasions the applicant must have been a Jury Member. ○ The other three occasions, experience in the following roles may also be accepted: Chief Range Officer, Chief Referee, Chief of Classification or Chief of Equipment Control. <p>World Shooting Para Sport A Level International Judges will be required to write reports when working as Supervisor for C or B Level International Judges. Such reports will be submitted to the World Shooting Para Sport office.</p>
Costs	The only case that travel and accommodation costs will be covered by the organisers is when certified A and B Level Judges are appointed directly by World Shooting Para Sport to attend World Shooting Para Sport competitions.
