## IPC Classification Co-ordinator (f/m/x)

The International Paralympic Committee (IPC) is the global governing body of the Paralympic Movement. The IPC supervises the organisation of the Summer and Winter Paralympic Games, and serves as International Federation for 10 sports, for which it supervises and co-ordinates the World Championships and other competitions. The IPC is committed to enabling para-athletes to achieve sporting excellence and to developing sport opportunities for all persons with an impairment from the beginner to elite level. The IPC aims to make for a more inclusive society for people with an impairment through para-sport and promotes the Paralympic values, which include courage, determination, inspiration and equality.

The IPC offers the position of a **full-time IPC Classification Co-ordinator (f/m/x)** in a multicultural and international team at the IPC Headquarters in Bonn, Germany, **starting as soon as possible**.

Reporting to the IPC Medical & Scientific Director, these will be your **tasks and responsibilities**:

- Assisting the IPC Membership in retrieving compliance with the 2015 Athlete Classification Code and International Standards
- Facilitating the implementation of classification rules and regulations in IPC Sports in accordance with the 2015 Athlete Classification Code and International Standards
- Co-ordinating classification opportunities in IPC Sports and classifier training/re-certification initiatives (in co-operation with the IPC Sports and the IPC Academy)
- Co-ordinating classification activities at IPC Major Events
- Supporting the development of sport-specific classification research through assisting classification research grant programs and classification research expert meetings
- Developing strategies for facilitating national classification and classification development initiatives and supporting the IPC Classification Committee

- Master degree in sports science with major orientation in biomechanics or kinesiology
- Have expertise and/or experience in the field of Para sport and have a strong interest in scientific concepts and methodologies related to sport-specific classification
- Excellent organisational skills
- Proven ability to meet deadlines, operate with limited supervision and multitask in a fast changing environment, including during occasional weekend work and business trips
- Computer literate in MS Office
- Good communication skills and excellent verbal and written command in English (knowledge in other languages is a plus)
- Detail-oriented and meticulous work manner
