<b>4. Eligibility</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. Athletes must be 14 years old by 31 December in the year of the competition;</li><li>b. Athletes must have an active IPC Athlete license for the 2019 season and must entered via the IPC Online Entry System;</li><li>c. Athletes with international "New", "Review" and "Confirmed" sport class status are eligible to enter;</li></ul>	





## 5. Classification

- a. International Classification assessments will take place following the procedures and policies of the World Para Athletics Classification Rules and Regulations.
- b. Physical Classification Assessments: 22, 23 and 24 April
- c. Visual Classification Assessments: 22, 23 and 24 April
- d. Intellectual Classification Assessments: 22, 23 and 24 April
- e. Athletes with a New or Review Sport Class Status will be required to undergo Classification prior to the competition. If there are too many athletes to be classified than the schedule allows, Nations will be allocated classification slots and will be asked to prioritize athletes for classification. In this instance, New athletes will still be eligible to compete.

## 7. Competition Rules and Format

The competition will be held according to the World Para Athletics Rules and Regulations 2018-2019. Described below are a few specific regulations for this competition:

### 7.1. Entry

- a. There will be no reimbursement by the LOC after the entries completion (including the fees payment).
- b. At the end of the registration period, participation will be considered confirmed and no future changes will be allowed;
- c. Each athlete is allowed to enter up to 3 (three) event/class;
  - i. Track wheelchair athletes will not have limit for events enter.
- d. Each NPC is allowed to enter, maximum, 05 (five) athletes per event/class;
- e. Athletes who Did Not Start (DNS) in an entered event will be not allowed to compete the next events, unless payment is made in the amount of R\$ 100,00 per event not started. The payment must be made at the competition office no later than 01 (one) hour before the next event to compete. Athletes who did not start will have the abbreviation DNS in the published results.





## **7.2. Competition**

- a. SÃO PAULO 2019 LOTERIAS CAIXA ATHLETICS OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS – World Para Athletics Grand Prix will be held in 04 (four) sessions;
- b. A minimum of 04 (four) athletes is required to open a valid event to medal, independently how many NPCs have been entered;
  - i. In case of athlete withdrawn (by medical withdrawal, e.g.), a valid event to medal with minimum of 03 athletes, the “minus one rule” will be apply for the medals awards. Less than 03 athletes, it will be a no medal event;
  - ii. To provide clarity, classes may be combined following the World Para Athletics Rules and Regulations 2018-2019, in case we do not reach the minimum number of athletes to open/validate an event;
- c. All track events will take place in direct finals by time. When the event has more than one heat the best result from all event/class heats will be considered for the final result;
  - i. For the combined events, the final results will be published by time, independently of the athlete’s sport class.
- d. Field events for ambulant and jumps will be held according to the World Para Athletics Rules and Regulations 2018-2019;
- e. Field seated events will take place in direct finals. All athletes will throw all the attempts directly. Once the athlete is at the sector he/she will make all the attempts.
  - i. For the combined field events, the final results will be published by marks, independently of the athlete’s sport class.
- f. To open a valid relay event medal is required a minimum of 04 (four) teams;
  - i. In case of team withdrawn (by medical withdrawal, e.g.), a valid event medal with minimum of 03 teams, the “minus one rule” will be apply for the medals awards. Less than 03 teams, it will be a no medal event;
  - ii. It will be analyzed the possibility for inscription of teams made by different NPC.

## **7.3. Super Final**

- a. The top 16 (sixteen) athletes by CTI (point system) at the events schedule (ATTACHMENT A) will be qualified for the Super Final:
  - i. The top 8 (eight) athletes by time will compete at the Super Final A;
  - ii. The 08 (eight) next athletes by time will compete the Super Final B;





- iii. When there are athletes of the classes T11 and T12, the events will have less than 08 athletes because of the guides;
- iv. If an athlete qualify for two or more events, in this case, the athlete can choose at the competition secretary which event she/he will compete;

#### 7.4. Award

- a. The top 3 (three) for each valid event/class will be awarded with medals;
  - i. In case of 03 (three) athletes the "minus one rules" will be applied for medal award;
- b. The Super Final will be awarded with medal by CTI, either Final A and Final B;
  - i. It will be also awarded the coaches and the guides (when there is) of each first place (gold medal) at the Super Final A and Super Final B;
- c. The top three relays teams will be awarded with medals;
  - i. In case of 03 (three) teams the "minus one rules" will be applied for medal award;

#### 7.5. Competition Technical Index calculation (CTI)

- a. The CTI calculation reference is the approximation to Athletics Index A for each event/class (ATTACHMENT B), as follows the formulas:

$$CTI \text{ track} = \frac{(IndexA - AT)}{Athlete \text{ result (mark)}}$$

$$CTI \text{ field} = \frac{Athlete \text{ result (mark)}}{(IndexA - AT)}$$

- a. SÃO PAULO 2019 LOTERIAS CAIXA ATHLETICS OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS – WORLD PARA ATHLETICS GRAND PRIX is a World Para Athletics approved competition. Only athletes internationally classified, status confirmed (C) or review (R), licensed for 2019 season will have their results recognized for international ranking.
